RESIDENTIAL OUTREACH PROGRAM

The County has made energy conservation a priority through encouraging energy improvement measures in homes and the reduction of inefficient vehicle use. Using funds from the Energy Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) program, Loudoun County aims to encourage home energy audits and energy retrofits, efficient appliance purchases, and energy-efficient transportation habits.

- **Homeowner Association Guide to Energy Efficiency**
 - A technical assistance and best practices guide for HOAs regarding implementation of energy efficiency improvements and on-site renewable energy technologies.
- **National Capital Home Energy Makeover Contest**
 - Loudoun County partnered with WJLA-TV to give away over \$30,000 in energy-efficient home improvements.
- **Energy Brochure with Piedmont Environment Council**
 - Loudoun County has formed a partnership with the Piedmont Environment Council to create a brochure that aims to help residents "Save Energy, Save Money, and Save Our Planet."
