### Loudoun County Hosts Free COVID-19 Testing Event January 27

Loudoun County has scheduled another free drive-thru COVID-19 testing event:

- **Wednesday, January 27, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.** at [Claude Moore Park, 46150 Loudoun Park Lane in Sterling](#).

The January 27 testing event is open to all. There are no age or residency requirements. No prescriptions or appointments are necessary. A person does not have to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 in order to be tested. A PCR test (nasal swab) will be administered, which tests for the novel coronavirus. No antibody or rapid tests will be offered. **No COVID-19 vaccine will be available at this event.**

#### Registration Form

To help reduce wait times, people who plan to attend the testing event are strongly encouraged to complete a registration form for each person who will be receiving a test prior to arriving at the testing site. The registration form is required and asks for general demographics and contact information, including name, date of birth, address, phone number and current symptoms, if any.

Forms will also be available at the testing site for individuals who do not have access to a printer or otherwise are unable to complete the forms in advance.
