

Catoctin District's School Enrollment Survey

Dear Catoctin Residents,

The Board of Supervisors is starting this year's budget discussions with LCPS on February 8. Based on what LCPS has told us so far, they predict their enrollment will rise by over 4,300 students next year.

That surprised me, given how 2020 went! So I've created a survey for families in Loudoun (and especially in Catoctin) to ask what you're planning to do, and to get your thoughts on LCPS's operations and their budget.

This survey was made and sent entirely by my office. It is not a Loudoun County Government survey, nor an LCPS survey. It is my effort as a Supervisor to learn how Loudoun families are responding to this year's school situation, and find ways that I can help.

We'll plan to use the survey results to help us ask important questions of LCPS at our joint budget meeting on February 8. If you have specific questions that you think we should ask, I've included space at the end of the survey so you can share those with us. We'd love to know what you think.
