Loudoun County Cancels February 11 COVID-19 Testing Event; Delays Opening of COVID-19 Call Center to 12:00 p.m.

Due to a forecast of inclement weather and out of an abundance of caution, Loudoun County is canceling the COVID-19 testing event scheduled for Thursday, February 11, 2021, at Philip A. Bolen Memorial Park. Anyone considering attending that event is encouraged to consider attending any of the other COVID-19 testing events scheduled for Tuesdays and Thursdays in February from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
