Community Development Block Grant Process is Underway in Loudoun

Loudoun County has opened the application process for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The CDBG program provides funding on an annual basis for local projects that address a variety of housing, public service and community development needs.

Eligible applicants for CDBG funds include local nonprofit organizations and local government entities in Loudoun County or those serving Loudoun County residents. Proposed projects should address the goals of the CDBG program which include providing affordable housing opportunities, revitalizing neighborhoods, renovating substandard housing, providing public services and expanding economic development opportunities, primarily for persons of low- and moderate- income households.

Application Release

Application Deadline: November 5

Applications for the Loudoun County CDBG program must be submitted no later than 2:00 p.m., Friday, November 5, 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.

Public Hearing on Housing and Community Development Needs: November 18

As part of the CDBG process, the Loudoun County Family Services Advisory Board will conduct a public hearing at 6:30 p.m., Thursday, November 18, 2021, to gather input on addressing housing and community development needs. The public hearing will be held virtually. Those interested in speaking during the public hearing are encouraged to sign up in advance.
