Loudoun County Invites Nonprofit Input for Coronavirus Relief Funding

Nonprofits serving Loudoun County residents are encouraged to complete a survey to assist the county in prioritizing programs for consideration in the second round of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. The <u>online survey</u> will close Friday, June 10, 2022.

This survey is a follow-up to a series of listening sessions through which Loudoun nonprofit organizations provided input on coronavirus relief funding earlier this year.

Loudoun County expects to receive a second distribution of ARPA funding this year. The first distribution of \$40,162,454.50, which is half of the allocated amount of \$80,324,909, was received in June 2021. The Board of Supervisors appropriated the first portion of funds to address immediate needs to assist areas of the county hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic, including \$2.5 million to nonprofit organizations. The second portion of funding also includes an allocation of \$2.5 million to nonprofits with a focus on continued COVID-19-related services.

All funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and must be spent by December 31, 2026.
