Voter Registration Deadline is October 17

Dear Catoclin residents,

An important reminder from Loudoun County election officials: If you aren't registered to vote, or need to update your registration, you have until **Monday, October 17**, to do that, so you can vote a non-provisional ballot in the November 8 general election.

Here are the specific voter registration deadlines that you need to know:

- **Online Voter Registration:** Monday, October 17, at 11:59 PM
- **In-Person Voter Registration:** Monday, October 17, at 5:00 PM at the Loudoun County Office of Elections and Voter Registration, 750 Miller Drive, S.E., Suite C in Leesburg
- **By-Mail Voter Registration:** The application must be postmarked no later than October 17

Same-Day Registration & Provisional Ballots

If you miss the October 17 registration deadline, you still have options. That's because this year, Virginia will allow [same day voter registration](#). Voters who haven't registered yet can show up, register, and vote a *provisional* ballot after October 17, up to and including on Election Day.

These provisional ballots are for use by voters who aren't registered yet at their polling location. They won't be processed by a vote counting machine at the time of voting, and they'll be subject to approval by the local electoral board.

Here's how Loudoun County General Registrar Judy Brown explained the process: "When we receive a provisional ballot, we gather information about whether the voter is qualified and eligible to vote. We then forward the information to the Electoral Board to review and approve or deny the ballot. If the voter registration application is approved and there are no other issues, the ballot will be counted. If the provisional ballot is not counted, the person who submitted it will receive written notice from our office."

Early Voting Deadline is November 5

All registered voters are [eligible to vote early in person](#). The deadline to vote early in person is **Saturday, November 5**.

You can go vote early at the Office of Elections and Voter Registration. Two more early voting sites will also open on **Monday, October 24**:

- **Dulles South Recreation Center**, 24950 Riding Center Drive, South Riding
- **Loudoun County Government Offices**, 21641 Ridgetop Circle, Sterling

You can find the exact hours for each early voting site [here](#). In general they're open on weekdays. But on **Saturday, October 29**, they will start offering weekend hours as well - and the **Carver Center** at 200 E. Willie Palmer Way in Purcellville will open as a fourth early voting site, for weekend hours only.
