Community Meeting for Village of St. Louis Set for January 31

Loudoun County will host a community meeting for the Village of St. Louis Tuesday, January 31, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. at Banneker Elementary School, 35231 Snake Hill Road, Middleburg. Residents are encouraged to attend to learn about the status of the St. Louis Village Plan and to provide feedback to members of the St. Louis Village Plan Task Force and representatives of Loudoun County.

The St. Louis Village Plan, which was initiated by the Board of Supervisors in 2022, is intended to help St. Louis maintain its unique character, support the community's goals and address a range of issues related to land use, development and quality of life.

In addition to an update on the village plan, residents will receive information about an opportunity for free well water testing and a potential community water feasibility study in the future.
