





In May, unknown subject(s) stole credit cards from an unlocked vehicle in Aldie. These cc were used in multiple transactions at 3 CVS in Maryland, store footage captured suspect above purchasing visa gift cards. Obtained transaction history, which was largely used in the Alexandria area (Lowe's specifically).

One of these gift cards was also used at the Alexandria DMV to renew a vehicle registration. LCSO partnered with VA DMV law enforcement and uncovered an additional suspect/associate as the DMV teller. Iris Arevalo, used her position to illegally renew the registration using one of the gift cards.

Associate of Milton Marquez Mata; both reside together in Alexandra, VA. The initial suspect, Reyes, identified in association. In September, LCSO and Alexandria served a search warrant on their residence.
