

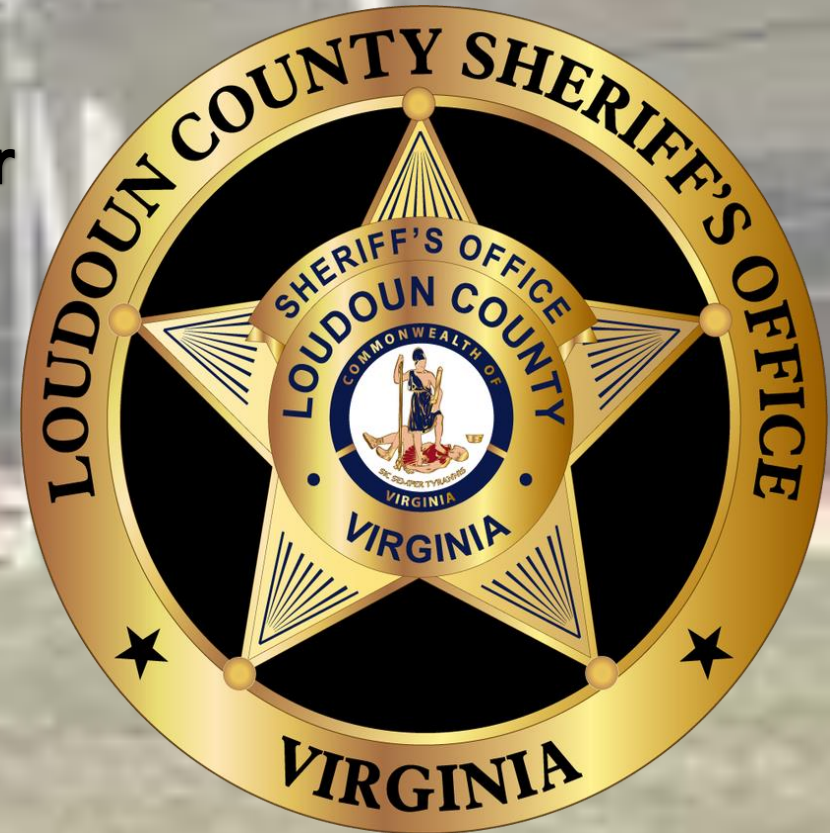

FINGERPRINTING

- ❖ Service free of \$5 cash only for out of county residents (Loudoun free)
- ❖ Mask requested for inside the room with confined space, lobby not required.
- ❖ Available to obtain up to 10 FD-258 Standardized cards though livescan machine.
- ❖ Your sole responsibility to send out to receiving party.
- ❖ Ink at HQ: 803 Sycolin Rd. SE Leesburg, VA 20175
- ❖ Will be turned away if no sworn personnel present because of safety.
- ❖ Reprints accessible – stays in system for 60-days after initial.
- ❖ Last person taken at 3:45 to guarantee end at 4:00.
- ❖ Ex: RN teaching licensing, VISA, etc.

Expungements

- ❖ See same requirements for fingerprinting
- ❖ LCSO sends to records, mailed to VSP in Richmond
- ❖ Follow up with state for processing, can take up to 6 months
- ❖ Bring copy of court documentation

Criminal History Checks

- ❖ Cost \$7 **cash only**
- ❖ Criminal conviction data from past 10 years by Loudoun (traffic infractions ARE civil)
- ❖ Full record through state police – online submission request
- ❖ Ex: Processing adoption agency and employment applications

Notary

- ❖ Bring one form of ID unless form states otherwise, driver's license acceptable
- ❖ No fee regardless of residency
- ❖ No restrictions on the number of forms needing notarization
- ❖ 2 certified notary publics for the Commonwealth of VA at DSS

Good Conduct Letter

- ❖ Verifies no outstanding record with station command signature in lieu of Sheriff and notarization
- ❖ Cost \$10 **cash only** per person
- ❖ Ex: Processing adoption agency and employment applications

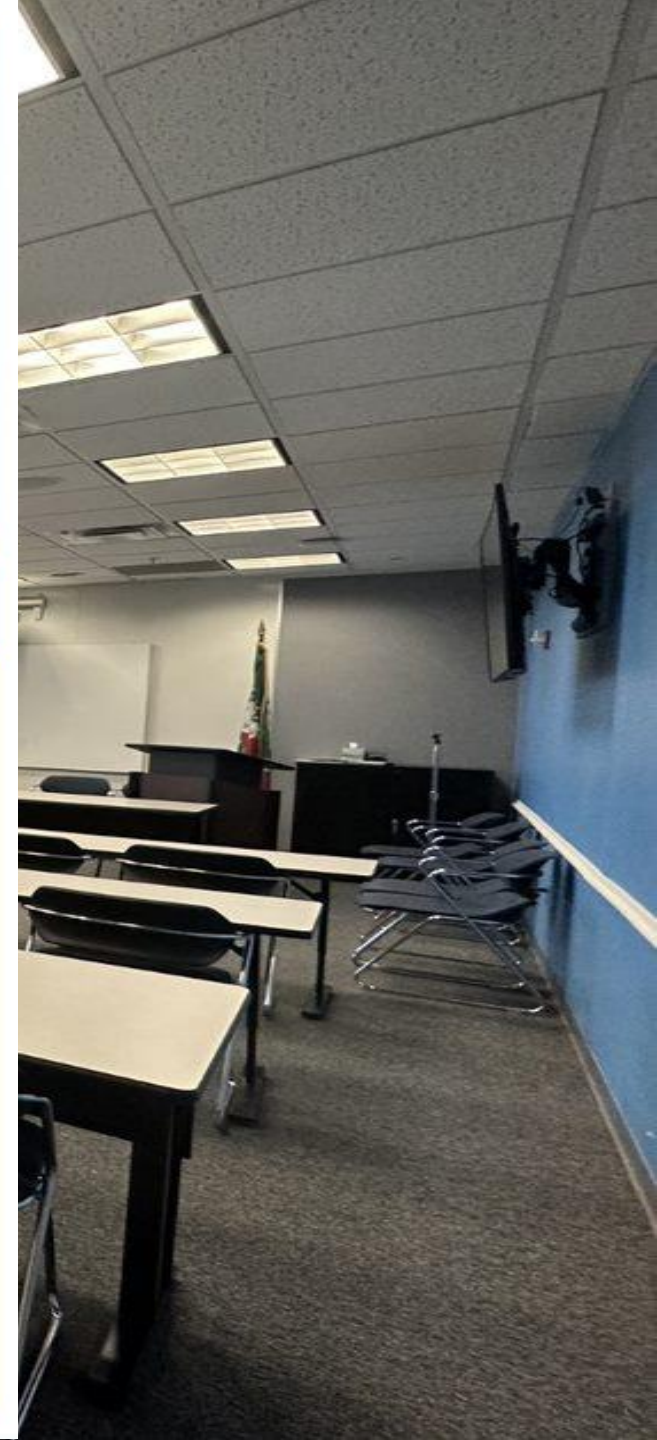
