### **Solarize NOVA Offers Loudoun Homeowners Free Solar Assessments, Discounted Prices on Solar Systems**

The [Solarize NOVA](http://www.solarizenova.org) program has returned to Loudoun County. Now through August 31, 2023, Loudoun County homeowners have the opportunity to sign up to learn more about solar power options specific to their property and take advantage of streamlined installation and financing processes.

In addition to free satellite solar assessments, the program offers discounted pricing on solar systems from vetted installers and connects participants with information on the current 30% federal solar tax credit and other incentives, including the Solar Renewable Energy Credit market. Property owners in Loudoun also may be eligible for [Loudoun County's Solar Energy Tax Exemption](#).
