Public Hearing on Housing & Community Development Needs Dec. 13

Loudoun County will hold a public hearing to gather residents' input on housing, homelessness, community development and public service needs in the community. The public hearing will be held **Wednesday, December 13, 2023, from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m.**, at the Department of Housing and Community Development, which is located at 106 Catoctin Circle SE in Leesburg. The hearing will be held on the first floor in the Olmstead Room.

The <u>Housing Advisory Board</u> is facilitating the public hearing as part of the county's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) process. The Housing Advisory Board is composed of members appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

Comments received at the public hearing will be considered in preparing Loudoun County's CDBG 2024-2025 Annual Action Plan that will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval and subsequently submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in May 2024.

The CDBG program, administered by HUD, provides funding on an annual basis for local projects that address a variety of housing, public service and community development needs.
