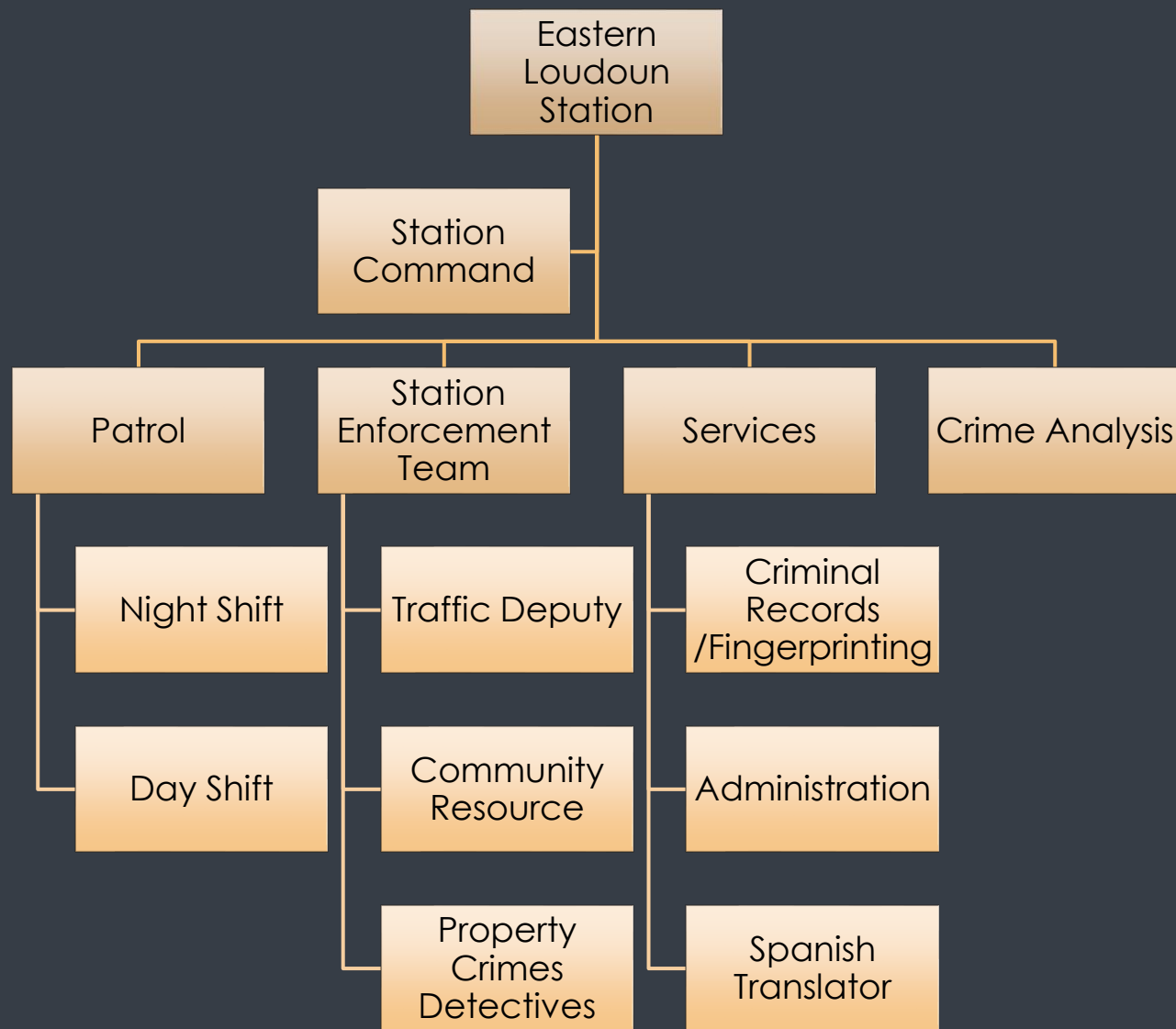

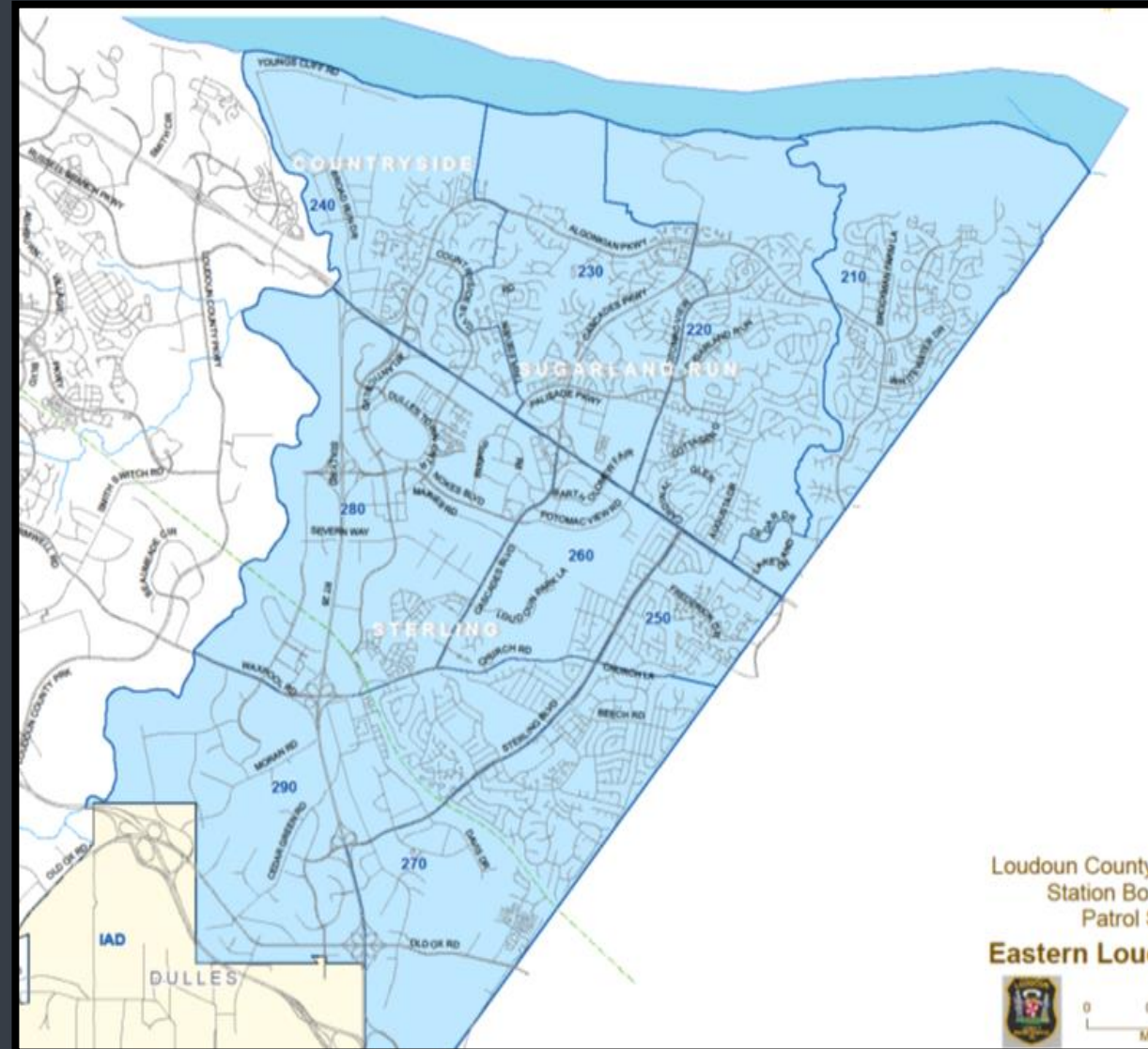

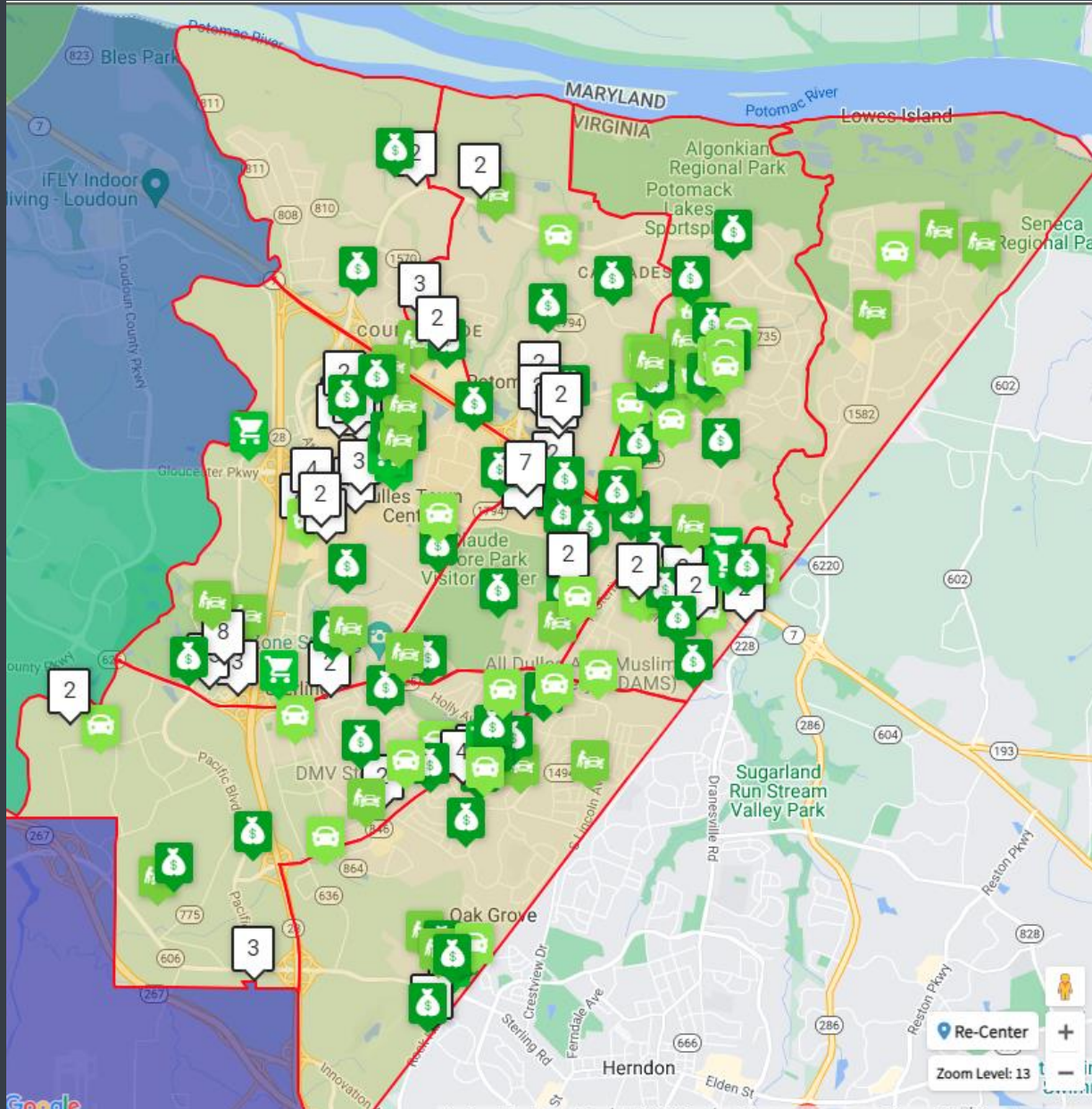

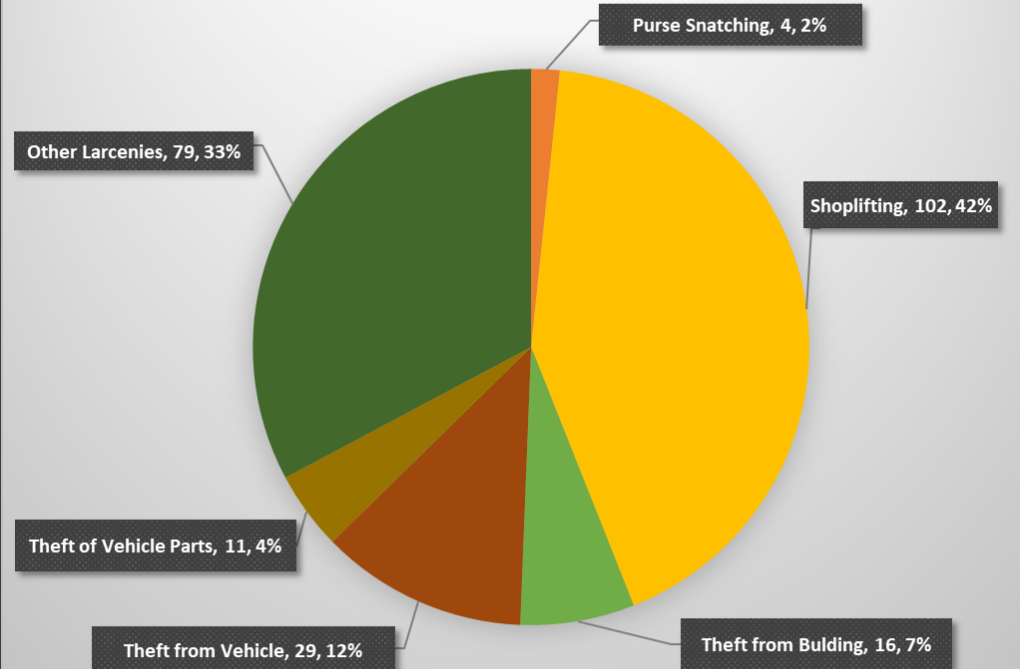

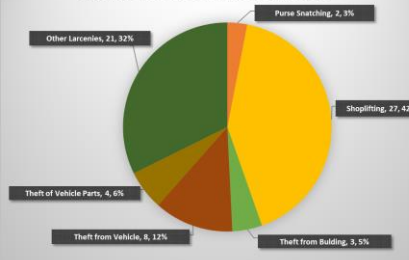

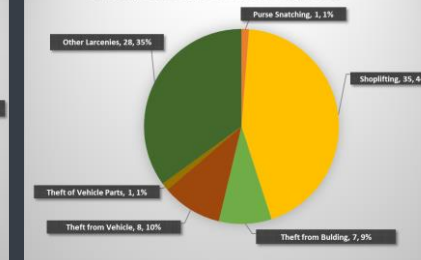
Larceny Cases by UCR Type  
Q2 (April-June) 2023



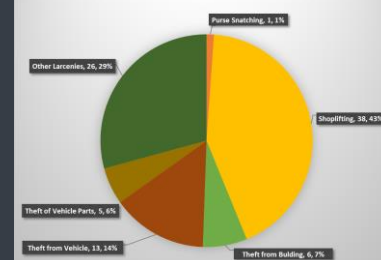
Larceny Cases by UCR Type | April 2023



Larceny Cases by UCR Type | May 2023

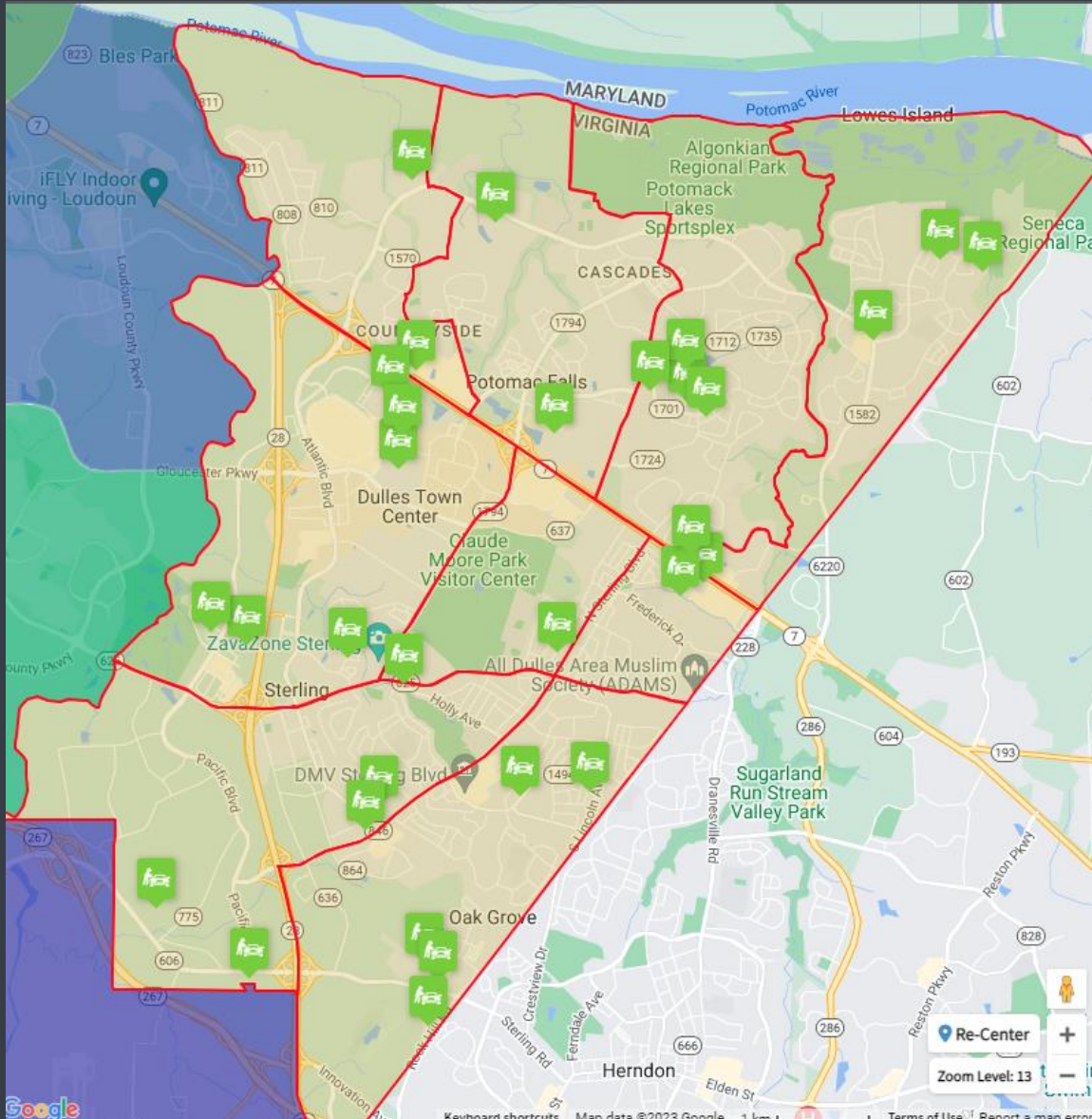


Larceny Cases By UCR Type | June 2023

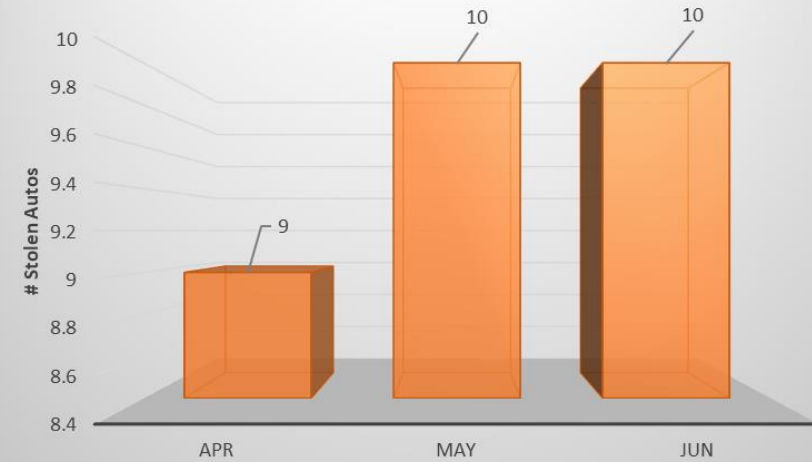




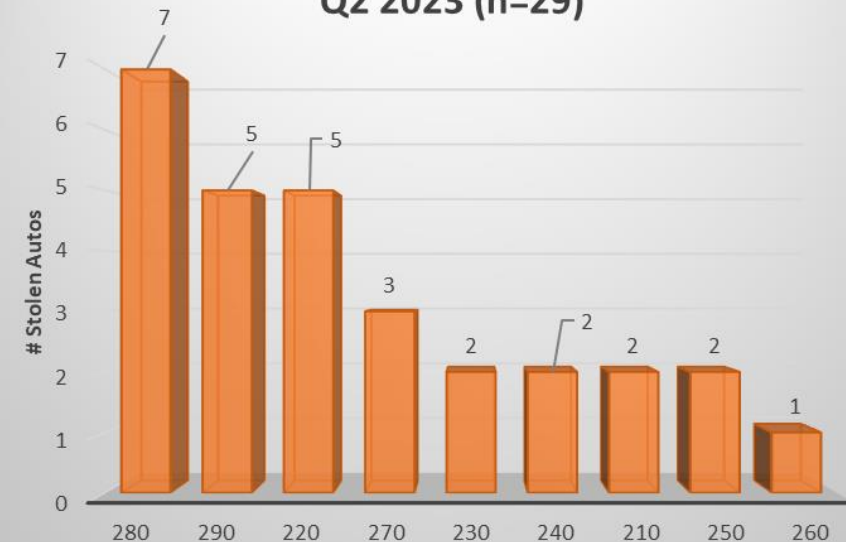
# Larceny – Stolen Auto

Q2 2023

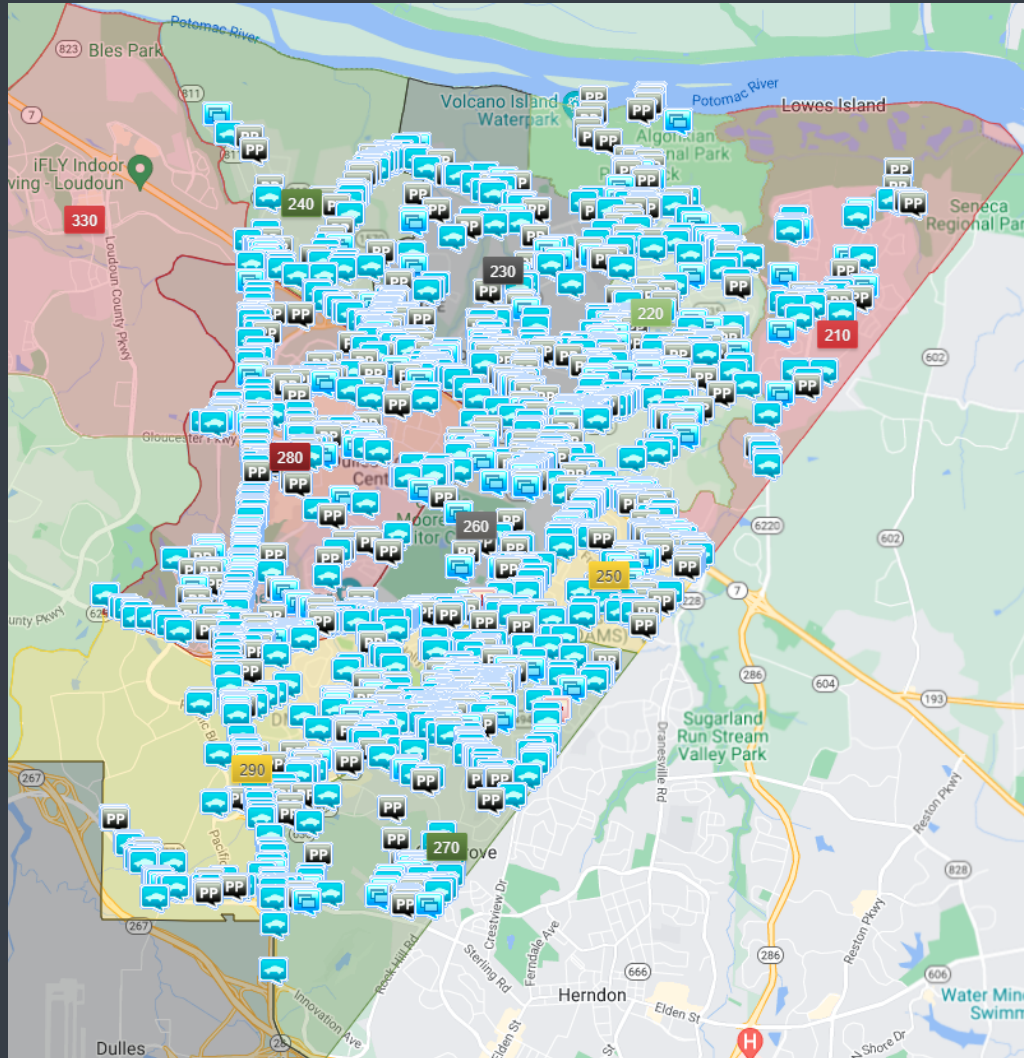


Total Stolen Autos by Beat  
Q2 2023 (n=29)

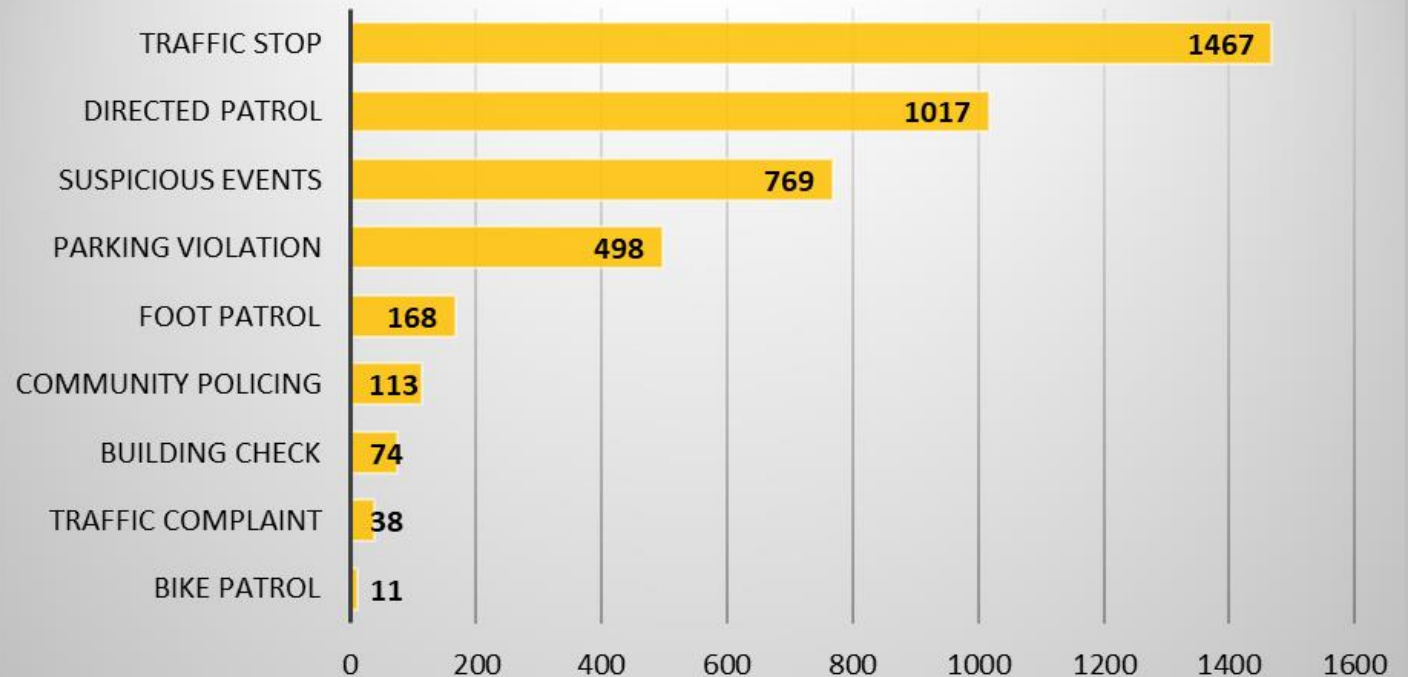

## April 1 – June 30, 2023



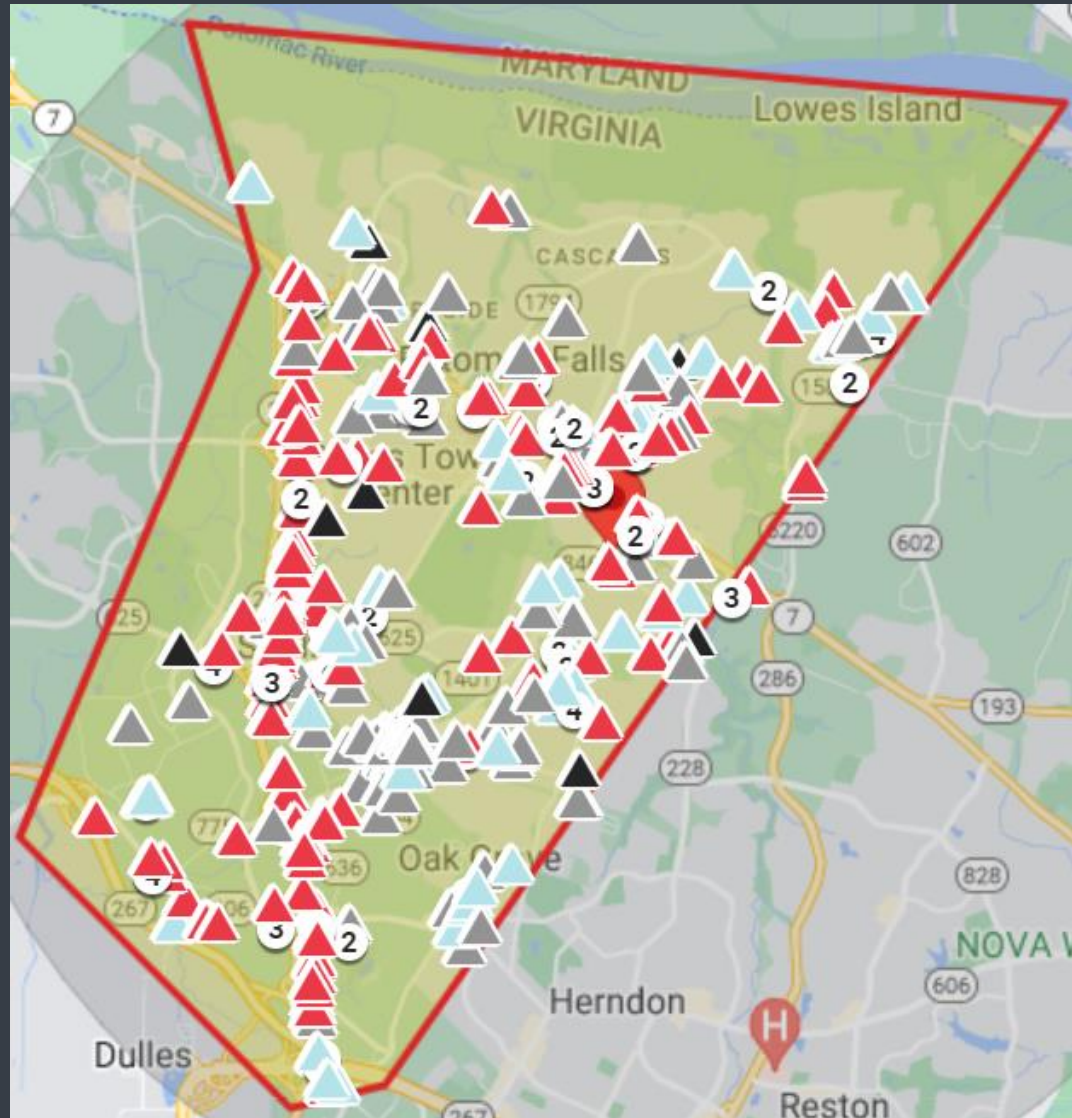
### Proactive Patrols (n=4,155)

# SIGNIFICANT CASES

## Findings



- ON 26 JUNE 2023, THE SUSPECT WENT TO CARMAX TO SIGN UP FOR A 24-HOUR TEST DRIVE OF A CAR.
- AFTER PICKING UP THE CAR, THE SUSPECT REFUSED TO RETURN IT TO CARMAX.
- THIEVES MAKING THESE TYPES OF THEFTS TYPICALLY USE FAKE ID'S. BUT LCSO WAS ABLE TO VERIFY THE SUSPECT'S IDENTITY THROUGH HIS RENTAL PAPERWORK.
- ON 01 JULY 2023 THE CAR WAS FOUND IN WASHINGTON D.C. NEAR THE SUSPECT'S HOUSE.
- THE SUSPECT WAS LATER ARRESTED IN WASHINGTON D.C.

# SIGNIFICANT CASES

## Preventative Measures



- LOCK YOUR CAR DOORS
- DO NOT LEAVE KEYS INSIDE YOUR CAR
- DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES IN YOUR CAR
- PARK IT IN A WELL-LIT AREA
- INSTALL A TRACKING DEVICE (EX. APPLE AIR TAG)
- INSTALL AN AUDIBLE ALARM SYSTEM AND ANTI-THEFT DEVICE
- INSTALL HOME SECURITY CAMERAS THAT COVER YOUR FRONT DOOR AND DRIVEWAY.
- REVIEW POST-COVID “NO CONTACT” MEASURES AT YOUR WORKPLACE
- WHEN POSSIBLE, CHECK CUSTOMER ID’S, CREDIT CARDS, ETC.
- WHEN IN DOUBT, CALL LCSO TO REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY.

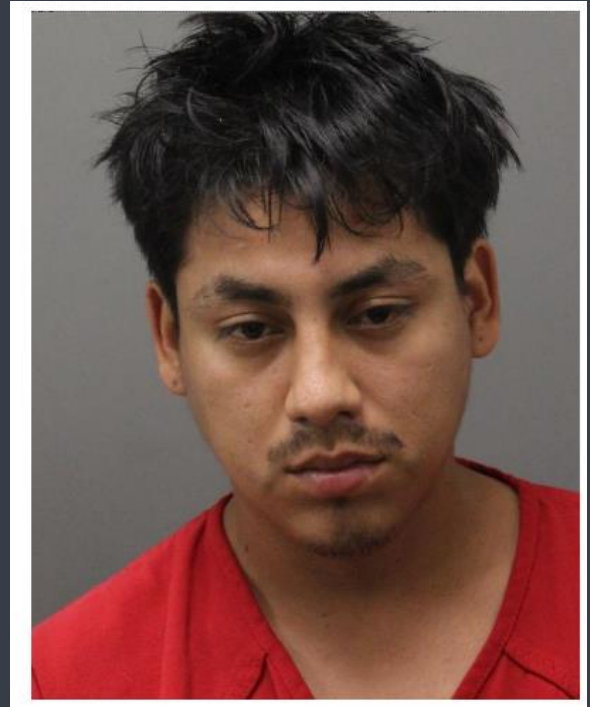

The Loudoun County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) has arrested and charged a Herndon man in connection with three armed robberies in Sterling over the past 36 hours.

The first robbery occurred at the 7-Eleven store in the 700 block of W. Church Road at approximately 1:46 am on May 14, 2023. A male entered the store, brandished a knife, and demanded money from the clerk. The second robbery occurred at the Sunoco gas station in the same area later that morning, at approximately 8:18 am. A male entered the store, brandished scissors, and demanded money from the clerk.

The third robbery occurred this morning at approximately 12:36 am at the Exxon gas station in the 45600 block of Falke Plaza, Sterling. A male approached the clerk with his hand in his pocket, making it appear like he had a weapon, and demanded money. In all three robberies, he was seen leaving the store in a grey Toyota Camry.

Deputies arrested Brayams Andino-Linares, 26, of Herndon this morning at a residence in the 700 block of West Church Road, Sterling, and charged him with three counts of robbery. Andino-Linares was transported to the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center where he is being held without bond.

### Armed Robbery / Assault Suspect



**Incident:** Armed Robbery

**Date:** Wednesday, June 7, 2023

**Time:** Shortly after 1:30 a.m.

**Location:** Exxon, 23050 Pacific Blvd., Sterling

**Details:** A male entered the store, displayed a handgun, and demanded money. The male struck the store employee in the head with the gun, before fleeing the area.

**Suspect Description:** The male was wearing a black face and head covering, a black sweatshirt with "New Balance" written on the chest in white, black gloves, black pants, black shoes, and a black bag.

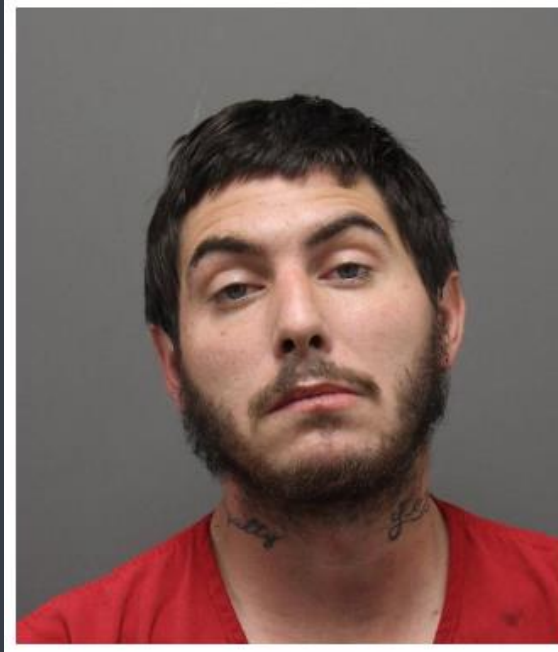

## New York Man Arrested After Committing Multiple Felony Offenses

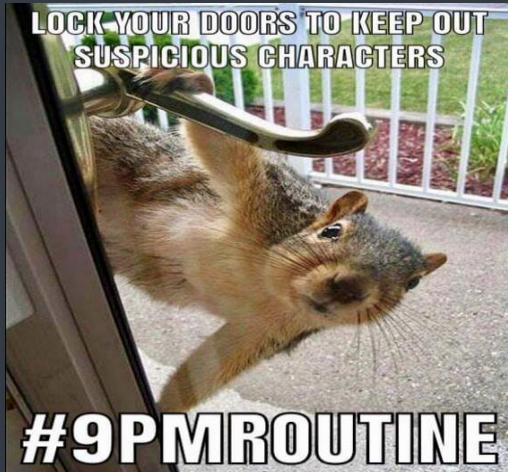
**Loudoun County, VA (July 24, 2023)** – The Loudoun County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) has arrested a New York man after he committed multiple felony offenses.

On Saturday, July 22, 2023, at approximately 8:24 a.m. deputies responded to the Sheetz gas station at 45555 Dulles Plaza in Sterling, for a report of two adults passed out in a vehicle. Deputies approached the vehicle and viewed suspected drugs and drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle regained consciousness and put the vehicle in drive, nearly striking two deputies.

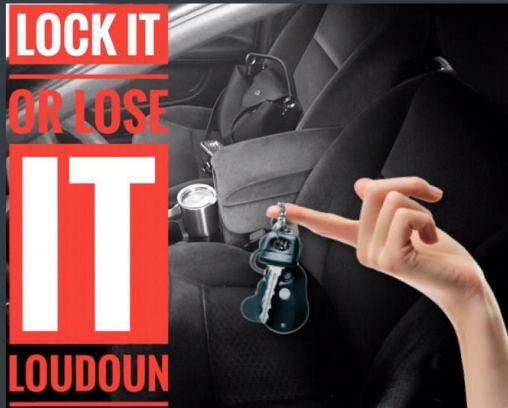
