03/19/2024	Ashburn	Crypto Bank Scam: Complainant reported receiving a phone call from someone claiming to be from Gemini, her bank. She was told to transfer money to secure accounts because her account was compromised. After transferring the money, the complainant was unable to access the accounts or reach anyone on the numbers provided. She then realized she was the victim of a scam. SO240005040.
03/19/2024	Sterling	Facebook Scam: Complainant reported replying to an advertisement for a home for rent and being required to pay money for the initial walkthrough. After transferring the money through Zelle and confirming an appointment, the complainant arrived only to discover that the house was not for rent and there had been other victims. She then realized she was the victim of scam. SO240005038.
03/19/2024	Sterling	Law Enforcement Scam: Complainant reported that someone called him and identified themselves as a member of the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office. The complainant was told he missed jury duty and there was a warrant for his arrest. He was further told he needed to deposit money into a Crypto ATM machine. After depositing the money, he realized he was the victim of a scam. The case is under investigation. SO240005013.
