Recently, the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office has received numerous reports of impersonation scams where individuals are pretending to be sheriffs' deputies and, in many cases, use legitimate names and ranks. In these scams, the bad actors are telling citizens that they missed jury duty and have warrants for their arrest. The callers go on to say that citizens can pay a fine for the warrants to be dismissed by way of mobile payment services, gift cards, or cryptocurrency.

Our Financial and Cybercrime Unit is working diligently to investigate these crimes and hold these criminals accountable.
