	Leesburg	Scam Attempt: Complainant reported a call from someone claiming to be an LCSO deputy who said that the complainant had an outstanding warrant for missing jury duty and could resolve the matter by sending \$5k in cryptocurrency. The complainant said that as he questioned the initial caller, he was transferred several times to "higher-ups," who tried to convince him to send the money. Complainant recognized this was a scam and hung up. SO240006807
	Lovettsville	Credit Card Fraud: Complainant reported that two credit cards had been opened in her name without her authorization. Both cards have outstanding balances, with one resulting in a "Warrant in Debt" to appear at the Loudoun County General District Court. Complainant also stated that she received a package at her home with a cashier's check and instructions for depositing the check and buying gift cards for the sender. Complainant recognized this was scam and did not take any action. SO240006802
	Ashburn	Rental Scam: Complainant reported that she sent a \$1350 deposit to a "property manager" for a rental she saw advertised online. The property manager then informed her that she could have a discounted monthly rent if she sent additional funds. Complainant refused, realizing this was likely a scam. Upon refusing, she was told the lease was being canceled and that she would receive a partial refund of her deposit. No refund was received, and complainant located the actual property owner who informed her that the property had not been listed for rent and there was no property manager. SO240006785
