Supervisor Matt Letourneau to Hold “Dulles Direct” Town Hall Meeting

As part of his “Dulles Direct” initiative to bring county government closer to citizens, Supervisor Matt Letourneau will be holding his third quarterly Town Hall meeting on **Wednesday, September 26** at 7 p.m. at Mercer Middle School.

Supervisor Letourneau is holding this meeting in Stone Ridge to make residents aware of an important issue regarding the configuration of Gum Spring Road. Staff from VDOT and from the Loudoun County Office of Transportation Services will be on hand to discuss a plan to significantly change traffic flow at the Route 50 intersection. Residents who travel this corridor are strongly encouraged to attend this meeting and help spread the word to your neighbors. In addition, **Dulles District School Board Representative Jeff Morse** will be present to give a back to school update. While the Town Hall meeting will be open to all, priority for questions and comments will be given to citizens of the Dulles District.

News Alert: Board of Supervisors Approves Athletic Field Initiative

Last night, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved Supervisor Letourneau's Athletic Field Initiative. This initiative directs county staff and the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Board (PROSB) to inventory actual usage at all county and school athletic fields, review existing MOU's with athletic leagues, and recommend field improvements and costs. It further requests the Joint Board/School Board Committee work with the PROS and staff to review the current status of LCPS shared use fields and provide recommendations for increasing use, as well as feasibility of the county taking over maintenance at school fields. Finally, this item directs staff to develop and implement a plan to provide portable restrooms at LCPS fields with the expense to be calculated by staff and reimbursed by field

users. A progress update will be provided to the BOS in November, with a final report completed in January 2013. Look for more information in next week's email newsletter, or click [here](#) to read the item approved by the Board.
