



Tonight: Important Public Hearing on Braddock and Pleasant Valley

Tonight VDOT will hold its official public hearing on the proposed improvements to the Braddock and Pleasant Valley intersection. This important meeting will be held at **Ormond Stone Middle School located at 5500 Sully Park Drive in Centreville, VA from 6-8pm**. There will be informational presentations on the design plans and you will have the ability to fill out comment cards and share your views with VDOT.

While I know it is not going to be convenient for many of you, this is the only official public hearing on this project. As I've discussed, there is a concentrated effort by the Virginia Run HOA in Fairfax County to flood VDOT with comments opposing this improvement. We'd like to see as many Loudoun residents as possible attend to ensure that the meeting is balanced.

Thanks to an unusually light Board of Supervisors Public Hearing agenda, I will be able to attend the hearing and will be available to answer your questions about the project. (For those of you who haven't met me, I'll be wearing a grey suit and will have a Loudoun County lapel pin on my suit coat).

If you absolutely cannot make the meeting tonight, I will also be holding an informational public meeting on this project on Thursday, October 17 from 7-9pm at Little River Elementary School in South Riding.
