## **Loudoun County Parkway Update**

Thank you to all of those who shared your support for my position that the Board should not approve any new homes in Brambleton without a commitment to finish Loudoun County Parkway. I'm pleased to report that a majority of the Board took that position. Minutes before the meeting, we received a letter from Brambleton's attorney stating that they would commit to constructing Loudoun County Parkway prior to requesting any zoning permits for their new development.
