

Town Hall Meeting Tonight and Dominion Power New Transmission Line Open House

Town Hall Reminder: I will be hosting my 2nd quarter Town Hall meeting tonight at 7:00pm at J. Michael Lunsford Middle School (26020 Ticonderoga Road). Joining me will be Delegate David Ramadan who will give an update on the General Assembly session.

We will also have updates on two major projects in the area. The design-build project team from VDOT and Fort Meyer Construction will present the construction plans for the **Braddock/Pleasant Valley Roundabout**. We'll also inform you of a major change that is currently scheduled to take place on or around April 29th involving the north side of **Gum Spring Road and Stone Springs Blvd and Route 50**. On this date, the section of Gum Spring Road adjacent to the StoneSpring ER and the hospital under construction will close to through traffic, and all traffic will use a new section of Stone Springs Blvd on the north side of Route 50.

As always, I will also update you on other projects in our District. I hope you can attend.

Dominion Virginia Power Open House: Dominion Virginia Power is planning a major new transmission line in the Route 50 corridor that will serve a new substation in the Poland Road/50 area. Dominion will be holding an Open House to share plans for the project, answer questions and receive feedback on Wednesday, April 29 at Little River Elementary School from 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm.
