



Important Voting Information, Including Dulles District Precinct Changes and Absentee Locations

In preparation for the November 3, 2015 election, I want to make you aware of some important voting information, including changes to where some of you vote. **If you have previously voted in the Little River (107), Freedom (112) and Carter (117) precincts, you may have a new voting location this year.**

If you live in any of the affected precincts, please watch your mail and be sure to open anything from the General Registrar's office in Leesburg. To confirm your polling place, you can click here (<http://www.loudoun.gov/index.aspx?NID=2782>) and enter your address.

PRECINCT CHANGES:

Loudoun County election officials have notified voters of several precinct changes in advance of the November general election. New voter identification cards were recently mailed to affected voters. The changes were made in order to ensure smooth, efficient elections with minimal waits. The changes are being made this year in preparation for next year's Presidential election, which typically sees high turnout. The precincts with changes are:



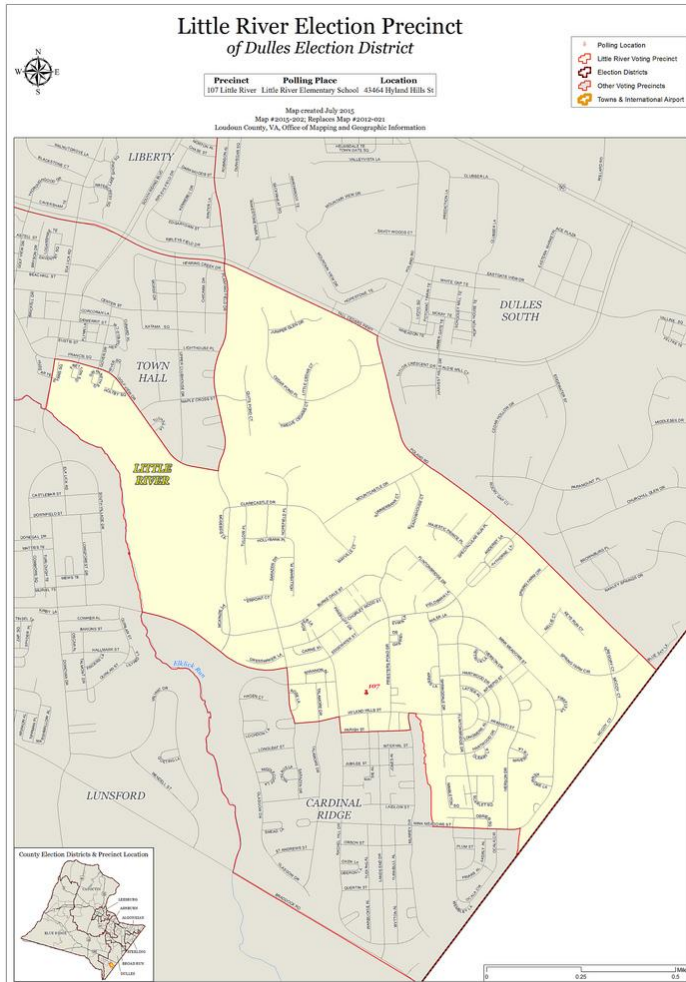

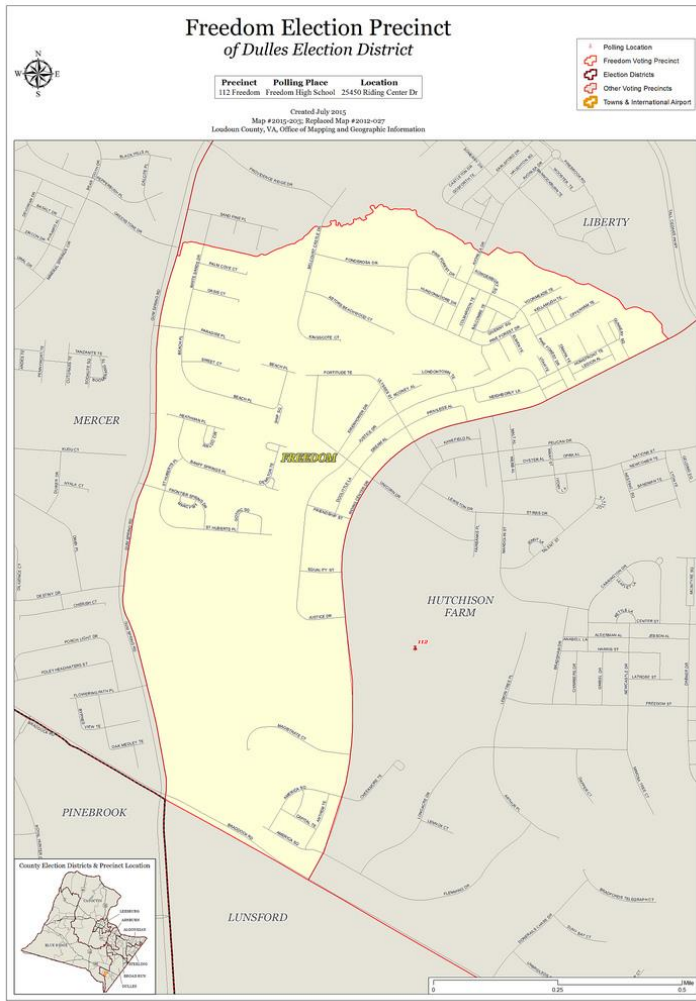

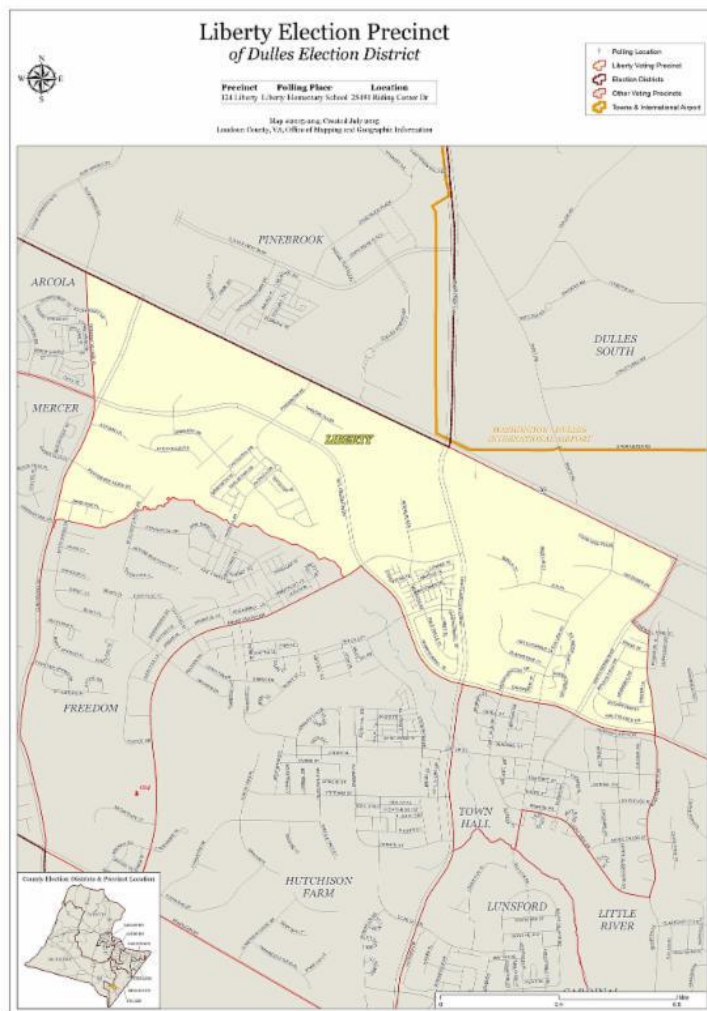

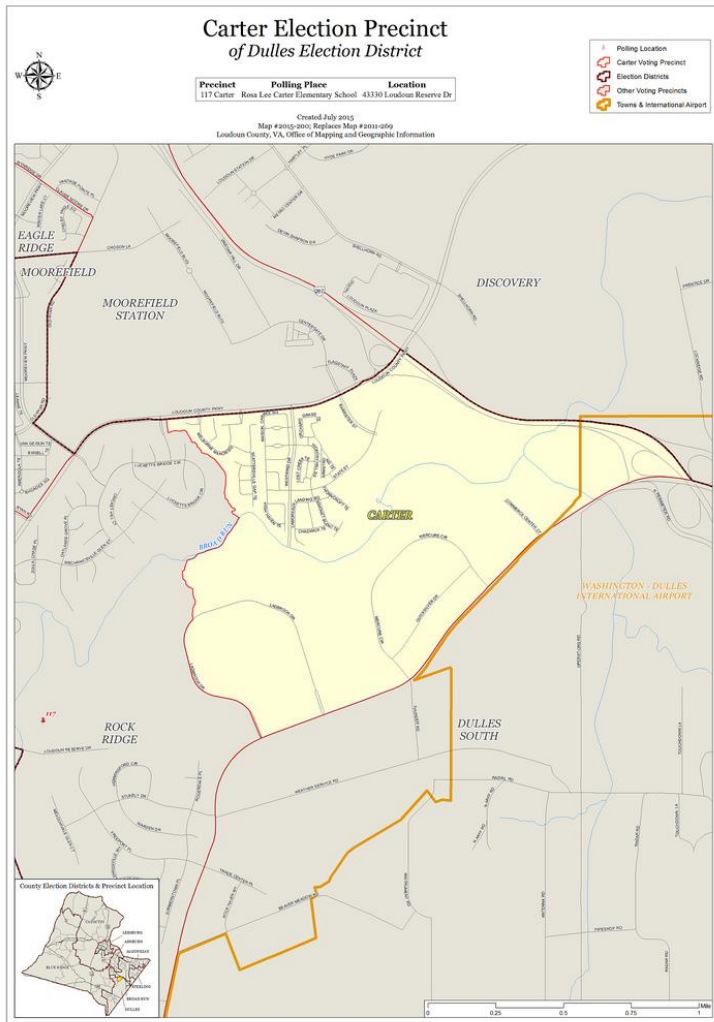


New Liberty Precinct:

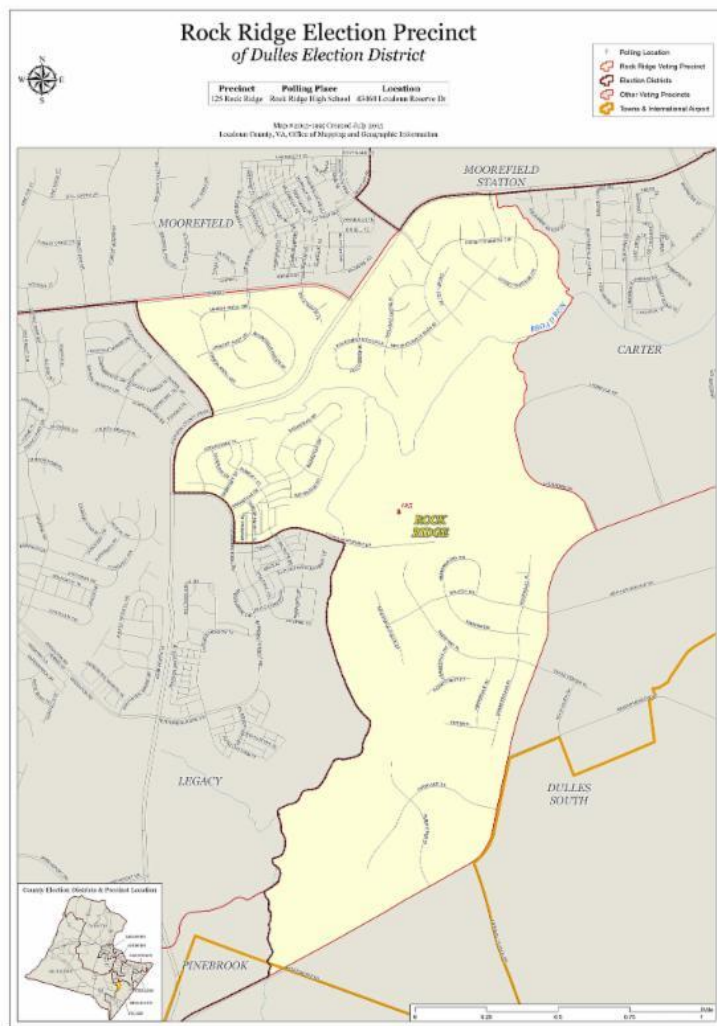


117 Carter (Rosa Lee Carter Elementary School) has been split creating a new precinct - 125 Rock Ridge (Rock Ridge High School)

ABSENTEE VOTING:

If you cannot make it to your precinct on Election Day, you may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot in person or by mail. Qualifying reasons to vote using an absentee ballot and instructions can be found on the Virginia Absentee Ballot Application Form at www.loudoun.gov/absentee.

In-person absentee voting for the November 3, 2015, general election is now underway at the Loudoun County Office of Elections, 750 Miller Drive, S.E., Suite C, Leesburg. Absentee voting hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Extended hours will be offered beginning Monday, October 26 through Friday, October 30 from 8:30 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturdays, October 24 and October 31, from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Absentee voting will also be offered at the Dulles South Multipurpose Center, 24950 Riding Center Drive in South Riding, starting Saturday, October 24 through Saturday, October 31. The schedule is as follows:

Saturday, October 24: 9 AM - 5 PM

Sunday, October 25: Closed

Monday, October 26 - Friday, October 30: 4 PM - 8 PM

Friday, October 31: 9 AM - 5 PM

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES:

Finally, the In-Person Voter Registration

Deadline: Tuesday, October 13, 2015 at 5:00

p.m. (office closed Columbus Day Monday, October 12)

By-Mail Voter Registration Deadline: Postmarked no later than October 13, 2015.
