I-66 Toll Meeting, Power Line Public Hearings, Hospital Job Fair and More

Meeting Tomorrow on Proposed Tolling of I-66 Inside the Beltway

VDOT is holding a series of public meetings to provide residents with information on their proposed Transform 66 Inside the Beltway Project ([click here](#)). The proposal involves converting I-66 to dynamically-priced toll lanes in both directions during morning and afternoon rush hours between I-495 (the Capital Beltway) and U.S. Route 29 in Rosslyn, along with implementing a series of multimodal improvements along the I-66 corridor. According to the Virginia State Transportation Secretary, tolls could be as high as \$7 during the morning eastbound commute and as high as \$9 during the peak of the afternoon westbound rush hour.

The Board of Supervisors adopted a position against the proposed tolls given the current burden we face with tolls on both the Greenway and Dulles Toll Road.

At the request of Chairman Scott York, VDOT has added an additional public meeting to their schedule so commuters in Loudoun County would have a chance to have their voice heard. The meeting will be held tomorrow, October 15, 7:00 pm - 9:00 pm in the Cafeteria at Farmwell Station Middle School (44281 Gloucester Parkway, Ashburn, VA 20147). If you use I-66, you should plan to attend.

As the November 3 election approaches, I wanted to remind you of some changes that have been made to precincts within the Dulles District. If you have previously voted in the Little River (107), Freedom (112) and Carter (117) precincts, you may have a new voting location this year.

If you live in any of the affected precincts, you should have received a new Voter ID Card by mail from the General Registrar's office in Leesburg. If you have any question on where to vote, you can confirm your polling place by clicking [here](#) and entering your address.

In-person absentee voting is now underway at the Loudoun County Office of Elections, 750 Miller Drive, S.E., Suite C, Leesburg. Absentee voting hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 am until 5:00 pm. Extended hours will be offered beginning Monday, October 26 through Friday, October 30 from 8:30 am until 8:00 pm and on Saturdays, October 24 and October 31, from 8:30 am until 5:00 pm.

Absentee voting will also be offered at the Dulles South Multipurpose Center, 24950 Riding Center Drive in South Riding, starting Saturday, October 24 through Saturday, October 31.

The schedule is as follows:

Saturday, October 24: 9:00 am - 5:00 pm

Sunday, October 25: Closed

Monday, October 26 - Friday, October 30: 4:00 pm - 8:00 pm

Saturday, October 31: 9:00 am - 5:00 pm
