



Major Signal Outage at Rt. 50 and Lee Road Intersection

VDOT has informed me that the signal at the intersection of Lee Road and Route 50 is not functioning and is on flash at this time due to a cable being cut. VDOT currently has a crew on site working to repair damage to the line that feeds the signal. The repairs are expected to take most of the day to complete.

In addition to the signal being on flash the following lane closures are needed for the repair effort:

- Left turn lanes eastbound and westbound on Route 50 at the Lee Road intersection.
- Left turn lane from Northbound Lee Road to Route 50.
