Below is a Special Alert from Dominion Resources:

To Our Neighbors in the vicinity of the Loudoun Compressor Station on Cove Point Lane in Leesburg:

We will be venting one of the natural gas pipelines that run through the Loudoun Compressor Station as part of a planned pipeline upgrade. Venting involves purging all the natural gas from a segment of pipeline to allow for maintenance or upgrades.

The venting is scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m., Monday, September 26,2016 and continue for several hours.

The venting will be monitored by Dominion personnel. In addition, we will inform local emergency management officials in advance and upon completion of the venting.

The gas will be vented through silencers at the compressor station to eliminate as much sound from the venting process as possible.

We appreciate your patience during this scheduled pipeline work. If you smell gas and are not in the vicinity of the venting, please take your normal precautions. Thank you.
