I just wanted to give you an update on the Ashburn "Colored" School before the weekend. On Sunday, October 9, from 9am - 2pm there will be a Community Clean Up and Restoration Day. Our County will come together to paint and clean the grounds of this historic site. Additionally, there will also be sign-up sheets for other nonprofits who will need assistance as the year goes on.

Parking is going to be tight. The Sheriff's Office will be providing assistance. Please consider another way of getting to the site if at all possible - walking, biking, parking legally off-site, etc.

There are currently four parking lots available:

- In the lot adjacent to the schoolhouse, which is to the north (20579 Ashburn
- Mr. Harry Saville will have some spots on his property, which is to the south (20635 Ashburn Road).
- At the Ashburn Volunteer Fire and Rescue Department, Station 6, 20688 Ashburn Road.
- There are about 25 spots on Carrleigh Court, which is north of the site.
