



News Alert: Commuter Bus Service Changes Begin Monday and Upcoming Overnight Detour for Route 606

Loudoun County Transit Commuter Bus Changes Begin Monday at East Gate and Dulles South Lots

Since opening the East Gate Park and Ride lot in 2015, I have been working to bring long haul bus service there. The ability to add long haul service was dependent on the County's acquisition of additional local transit buses, which would be utilized on Metro connection routes to free up existing long haul buses for service elsewhere. After some manufacturing delays, the County received those local transit buses and placed them into service.

I'm pleased to say that starting on Monday, February 6 Loudoun Transit will launch long haul commuter bus service from East Gate in addition to the existing Metro connection.

Loudoun Transit also has made changes to some existing routes that run from the Dulles South Park and Ride. These service changes are based on input from riders and are designed to alleviate overcrowding, shorten existing trips and increase reliability.

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Overnight Detour February 7 on Route 606 for Power Line Work

There will be an overnight detour of Route 606 traffic on Tuesday, February 7, 9:00 pm to 5:00 am (if weather does not cooperate, the back up will be the following day, February 8th). Both Lanes of 606 will be closed between Overland Drive and Pebble Run Place and all traffic will be detoured onto those roads for the duration of work.

The detour is necessary for NOVEC to install new power lines across Route 606 near Carters School Road. Because the power lines cannot be de-energized for the project, traffic cannot continue through the work area. The detour has been coordinated with Fire and Rescue and the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office. State Police will be on hand for traffic assistance.

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
