

Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Station Populations




Eastern Loudoun Station Population: *81,899*

Dulles South Station Population: 109,856







Scammers Claiming to be Law Enforcement & Utility Companies!

Law Enforcement: Recently several residents reported receiving calls from a person claiming to be a Sgt. Jackson with the warrants division of the Loudoun Sheriff's Office. The caller claims you have a warrant issued for your arrest and you need to pay monies with a money card.

Utility Company: Several residents and businesses reported receiving calls from a person claiming to be with Dominion Power. In each case, the caller said the victim owed back payments and their electricity would be

disconnected if they did not pay.

Utility companies and government agencies will NOT contact you demanding immediate payment by money cards!

With the latest technology, the wireless office on wheels offers all DMV services:

- Apply for or renew your ID card available for adults, children and veterans.
- Apply for or renew your driver's license - take road and knowledge tests; get your picture taken.
- Reinstate driving privileges.
- Get a copy of your driving record.
- Obtain vehicle titles, license plates, decals, transcripts.
- Purchase hunting and fishing licenses and temporary boat registrations.

- Apply for copies of Virginia birth, death, marriage, and divorce certificates.
- Obtain E-Z Pass Transponders.
- Recently moved? Stop in to update your address on your DMV record. At the same time you can update your voter registration address and organ donor status.
- Order disabled parking placards
- Request a Personal Identification Number
