





Dear Sheriff Chapman

Sometime in the evening of 5 April a motor cyclist left the road near the intersection of Kidwell Road and Harpers Ferry Road. The motor cycle ended up in our pasture bordering the road and screened from the road by trees and brush and was not discovered until near noon today (6 April).

The accident was on a busy road and the incident was extended because of difficulty finding the body and then of removing both the body and motor cycle. The scene was managed by Captain Gary Gaither who organized the traffic control and the search for the cyclist and who, when he realized that the he was not dealing with an in and out accident, called up the appropriate traffic control vehicles. He coordinated with me, the property owner, to get access to first the motorcycle and then the body seeking and using a route best followed in consideration of the extreme wetness of the pasture — near quagmire. When cycle and body had been removed another representative of the Sheriffs department appeared to get information with respect to me and the property damage —fencing of a sheep pasture —that had occurred.

The purpose of this letter is to recognize the outstanding job done by Captain Gaither in managing a situation of some complexity and the competence of the supporting individuals. My wife who for seven years was the only EMT/Cardiac technician in the southern third of Virginia Beach said she had never seen a better managed accident scene and threatened that if I didn't write she would..

Too often all we see is flashing lights when we haven't been paying attention to our driving.

Thanks to you, Captain Gaither, and your department for a job well done..



I would like to commend the police officers who quickly responded to an incident at my workplace today. This morning around 9am there was loud shouting and screams for help in the lobby of our medical complex. Upon rushing into the lobby, I witnessed a large man assaulting a much older and far smaller man. He was choking him and screaming he was going

to kill the smaller man. It was a chaotic scene. Two young women were with the large man and they were shouting and screaming also.

Several male employees from the building attempted to intervene, but the larger man continued to advance towards the smaller man, even after he was retreating into a corridor trying to get away from him.

I instructed my co-worker to call 9-1-1 and officers were on the scene within minutes. The officers were very professional. They separated the men and spoke calmly to them, but the larger man continued to yell. After the officers asked the man to step outside, apparently trying to get him to cool off and defuse the situation, the man continued yelling. At one point it looked like he swung or shoved one of the officers (Franco, I believe) and all three officers acted swiftly, taking the man into custody.

Since it was raining very hard outside, the officers brought the man back into the lobby and asked him to sit. He continued to resist as the women who were with him were screaming profanities at the officers and telling them they were doing a terrible job. At no point were the officers rude or disrespectful to the man even while he continued to yell. He sat for only a few moments before jumping up and rushing towards one of the officers while still in handcuffs. At that time the officers escorted him out of the building and placed him in their police car. This upset the women with him. They continued screaming. There behavior was very disruptive to our medical practice and our patients waiting to be seen.

I would like to thank the police officers who promptly handled this situation with the utmost professionalism. They were very thorough in their investigation. They remained calm during a chaotic situation.
