Explain the circumstances on why you are paying this compliment:*

While driving North on Ashburn Village Blvd tonight, my wife and I came across an elderly gentleman walking in the middle of the roadway. It was very apparent that he was lost. I stopped in the lane he was walking in and put my hazards on as to prevent the man from getting hit. He was wearing pajama pants, a sweater and hat. I made contact with the man and it was obvious he was disoriented, and did not speak English. I continued to walk with him to prevent him from getting hit, and my wife called 911. The

dispatcher stated by my wife's description that this was the man that was reported missing by his family, and that they had been looking for. Within 2 minutes of making the phone call, 3-4 LCSO deputies were on the scene. The first deputy stated they had a translator coming to speak to the man, but that this was in fact the man they had been looking for. I just wanted to say how impressed I was with the response of your deputies in this matter. It was a great feeling to know that we have that kind of response from our department, and such a call was taken so seriously. I applaud you all, and thank you for your help tonight, and for everything you do for the residents of Loudoun County. I am sorry but i did not obtain any of the deputies names that arrived. So if you could just pass along to them "Thank You," from the guy who stopped [REDACTED]
