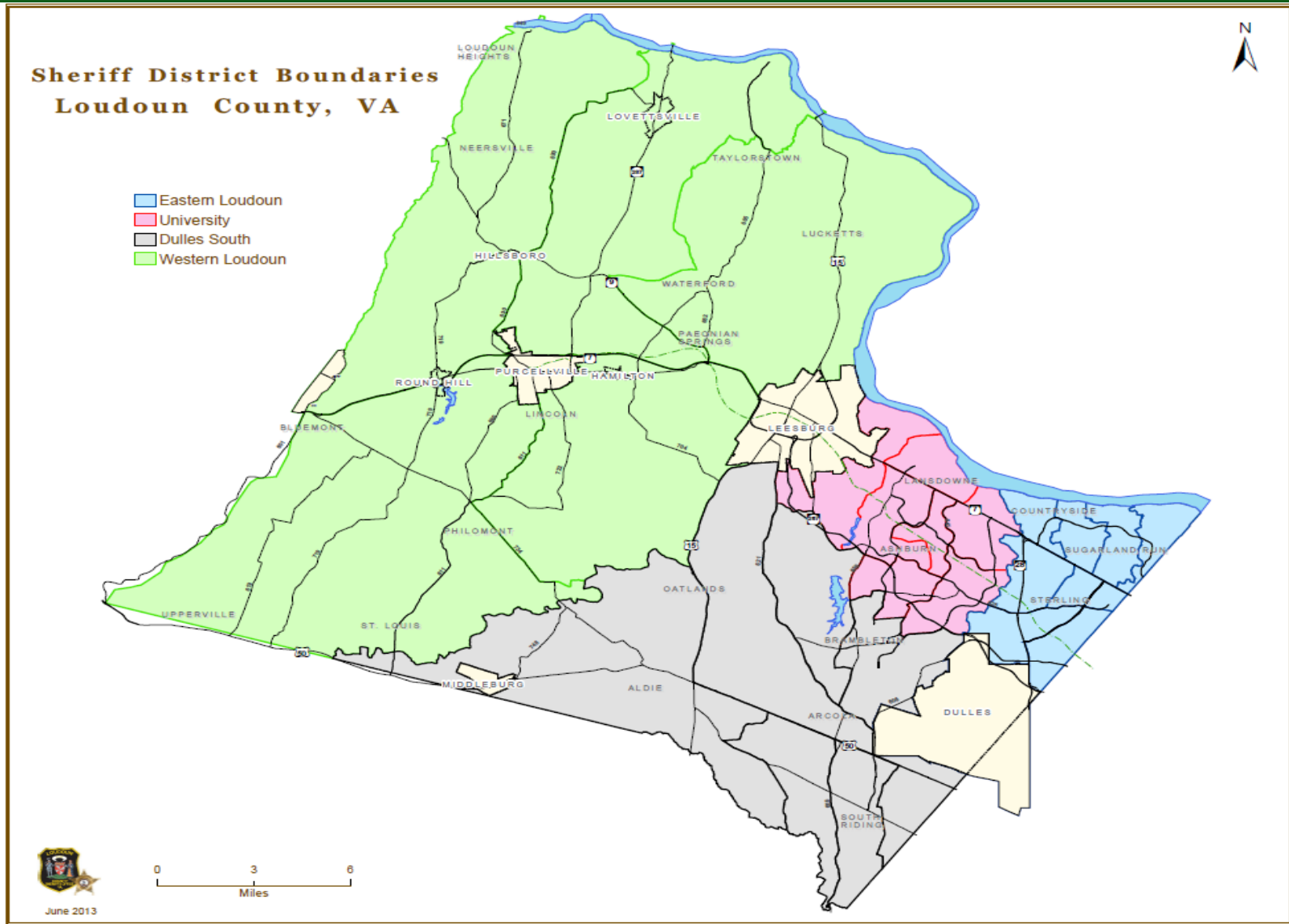

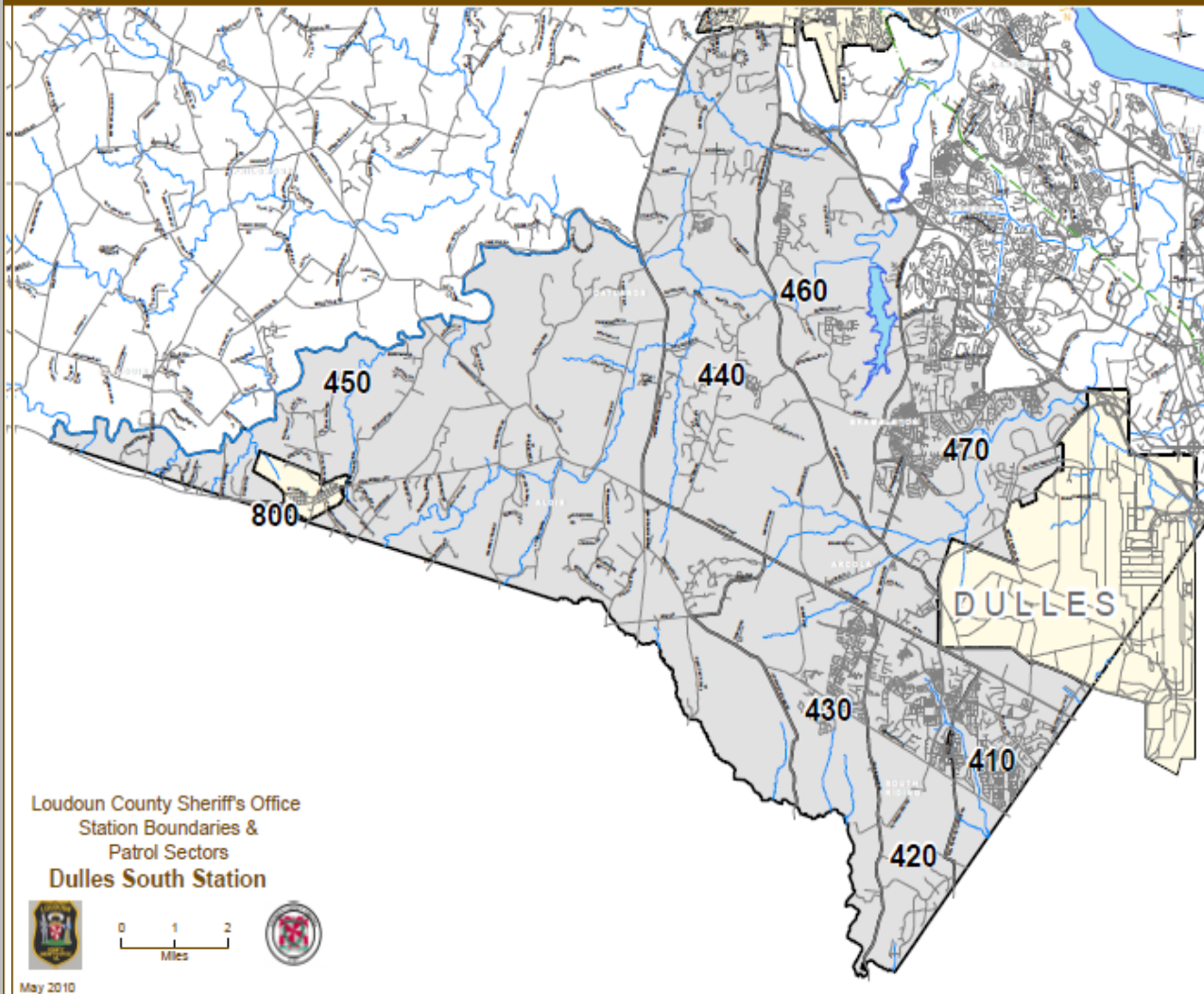


# Sheriff's Office Station Boundaries

# Significant Incidents

- **A Manassas couple was charged in December after being involved in a rash of thefts in South Riding area. Suspects stole two vehicles.**
- **Over \$900,000 of marijuana recovered in joint operation with DEA. Narcotics arrived via a nationwide ground transport company in December. Suspect who picked up narcotics was taken into custody while in possession of a rental truck.**

- ▶ Apply for or renew your ID card – available for adults, children and veterans.
- ▶ Apply for or renew your driver's license – take road and knowledge tests; get your picture taken. Reinstate driving privileges.
- ▶ Get a copy of your driving record.
- ▶ Obtain vehicle titles, license plates, decals, transcripts.
- ▶ Order disabled parking placards or plates.
- ▶ Purchase hunting and fishing licenses and temporary boat registrations.
- ▶ Apply for Virginia birth certificates.
- ▶ Recently moved? Stop in to update your address on your DMV record. At the same time you can update your voter registration address and organ donor status.
- ▶ Request a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to set up a myDMV account – receive DMV notices via email or phone; conduct secure transactions on the DMV website, [www.dmvNOW.com](http://www.dmvNOW.com).
- ▶ Search for other state services through a Virginia Internet portal.

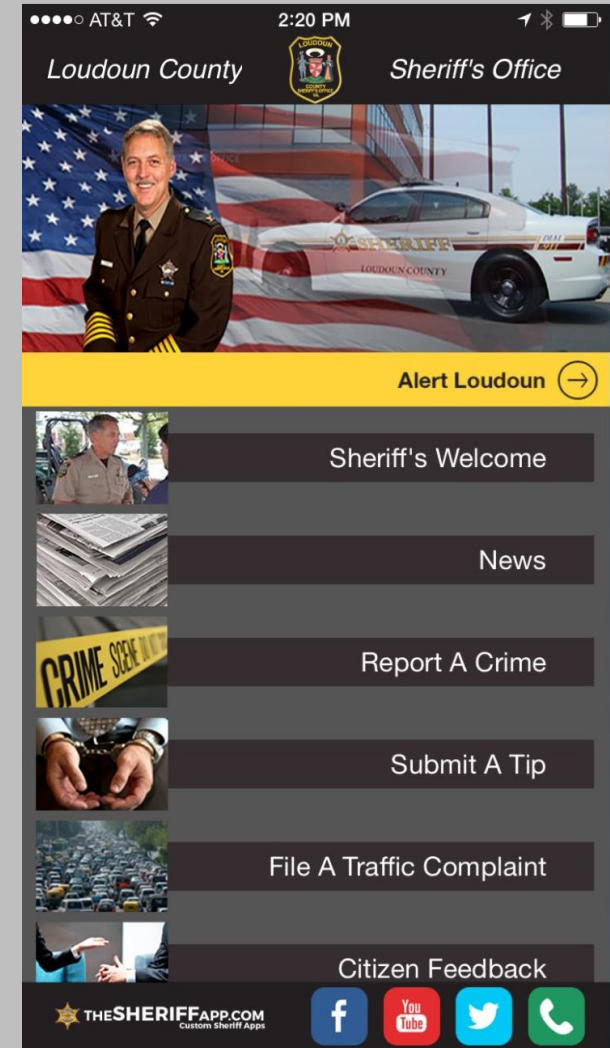

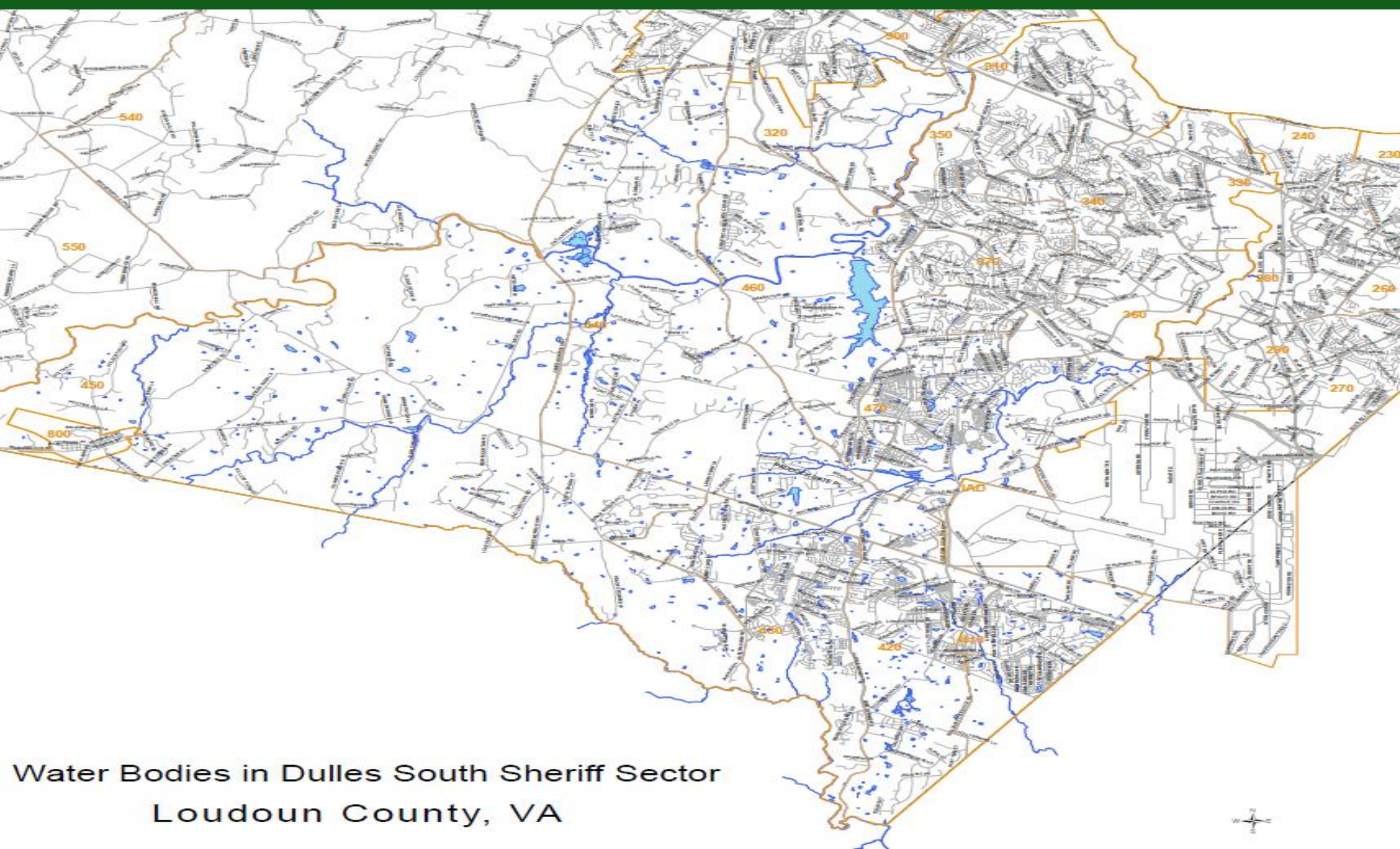
