Notice from Loudoun County Health Department

Out of an abundance of caution, the Loudoun County Health Department is informing people who were at two specific locations in Loudoun County on August 17th and August 20th that they may have been exposed to a person with measles. Health officials are mounting a coordinated effort to identify people who may have been exposed. Listed below are the dates, times and locations of the potential exposure sites associated with the case of measles.

- Inova Medical Center at 205 Hirst Road, Purcellville on Friday, August 17th from 8:00 to 11:30 am
- 2 Riverbend Building at 44084 Riverside Parkway, Lansdowne on Monday, August 20th from 1:00 to 5:00 pm

Rockwool Factory

I oppose the construction of the Rockwool factory in Jefferson County, West Virginia. I realize this is not our County (or even State) but because it will

impact western Loudoun, I feel it is appropriate to offer my thoughts. The concern is that the smoke that will be emitted has quite a few chemicals in it - things like benzene, formaldehyde, nitrous oxide that no doubt will waft into Loudoun County. Just because a company has the right to do something, does not make it the right thing to do. I would encourage elected officials in Jefferson County to listen to the voices of their constituents. There has to be a balance between the economy and the environment and I believe Rockwool Group could reach that balance if it chose to do so.

Bolen Park Stadium

The Board of Supervisors public hearing to rezone Bolen Park and the Leesburg Park-and-Ride Lot to develop a soccer stadium, training facilities, shared parking, and associated improvements is Wednesday, September 12th at 6:00 pm. Arcola Center

The Board of Supervisors public hearing to expand the industrial park zoning district to allow up to 2,350,000 square feet of data center development in the Arcola Center is Wednesday, September 12th at 6:00 pm. The applicant is proposing to convert approved retail, office, and commercial uses to industrial use, relocate a public use site, remove commercial and residential phasing, revise the timing of certain road improvements, remove pedestrian/road linkages interior to the development, reduce open space and relocate the proffered elementary school.

In order to expand the industrial district to construct the desired amount of data center uses, the applicant must amend the approved land use maps that would eliminate the "The Offices," "The Central Park," "The Business Park," and, the "Main Street" to accommodate a proposed "Corporate Park." Investing in Transportation

On August 9th, I attended a ribbon cutting ceremony for the widening of Waxpool Road from Unbridled Way to Faulkner Parkway. The project widened 3,400 linear feet of Waxpool Road from two-lanes to a four-lane, median-divided roadway with an asphalt trail on portions of the north side of the road and a sidewalk on portions of the south side. A traffic signal was also installed at the intersection of Ashburn Village Boulevard and Waxpool Road.



Beginning on or about Monday, August 27th at 9:30 am and continuing until Friday, August 31st at noon, Lockridge Road will be closed for silver line construction. Please see the detour route below.
