



Dear Leesburg Resident,

This is a reminder e-mail about the Route 7 bypass widening community meeting on Tuesday, September 18th from 6:30 to 8:30 pm in the Board Room of the Loudoun County Government Center, 1 Harrison Street, SE in Leesburg.

Both Loudoun County and the Town of Leesburg have had plans on the books to widen the Bypass from the existing 4 lanes (2 lanes in each direction) to 6 lanes (3 lanes in each direction). In January 2018, the Board of Supervisors received a report on the likelihood that 8 lanes (4 lanes in each direction) are recommended to handle existing and future traffic. The Board directed staff to study the issue and report back. This issue is expected to come back before the Board of Supervisors early next year. As I've spoken with residents along the Bypass, the topic of a sound wall has come up. Please think about whether a sound wall is something you want the Board to fight for in attempting to lessen the impact of a widening project on you and your family.
