

Dear Sterling District Residents,

I wanted to provide an update to the Sterling community on the situation on Route 606, better known as Old Ox Road. For many years there has been a problem with commercial vehicles parking on the shoulder of the road from the stretch of the road from the Sheetz gas station off of Route 28 working towards Herndon. This is a safety risk to motorists and pedestrians via constricting the highway, is an eye sore, and takes away space available for vehicles which need to legitimately stop on the side of the road during an emergency.

This has been a great concern to Sterling residents and I have worked hard to rectify the situation. My office has worked closely with Supervisor Meyer's office, the Virginia Department of Transportation ("VDOT"), and Loudoun County's Department of Transportation and Capital Infrastructure on this matter. I am pleased to inform you that VDOT has now accepted the request from Supervisor Meyer and me to prohibit parking on the shoulder of Old Ox Road in this area. VDOT has informed us that no parking signs will go up before the end of 2018 but I will work to get VDOT to complete this task as soon as possible. If there are any unexpected delays, my office will update residents but I hope that the signs go up in a timely manner.
