## **Schedule and Process**


Public input, refined by stakeholders and partner agencies, is used to develop project concepts. Concepts will then be evaluated and presented to the public to generate feedback on final recommendations.

June/July 2017 Public Input

- Approximately nine miles in length
- Whites Ferry Road to the Maryland State Line (including the Village of Lucketts)

## Background

- The County Board of Supervisors initiated the project in May 2017
- This open house will focus on the northern end of the corridor, building upon the public and stakeholder meetings, which were held during the Spring and Summer of 2018
- On September 20, 2018, the Board of Supervisors directed County staff to begin design of improvements on Route 15 from Battlefield Parkway to Montresor Road
