Lovettsville Special Election February 5; Voter Registration Deadline is Jan. 22

A special election for two seats on the Lovettsville Town Council will be held Tuesday, February 5, 2019. Only registered voters who live within the Lovettsville town limits are eligible to vote in the election.

The deadline to register to vote for the February 5 election is Tuesday, January 22, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. for those registering in person and 11:59 p.m. for those registering online.



Absentee voting for the special election is currently open at the Loudoun County Office of Elections and Voter Registration weekdays during regular business hours, which are 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. As a reminder, the office will be closed Monday, January 21, 2019, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

The last day to apply online, by fax or by mail to request that an absentee ballot be mailed is Tuesday, January 29, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. The last day to vote an absentee ballot in person is Saturday, February 2, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. The Office of Elections and Voter Registration will be open Saturday, February 2, 2019, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for absentee voting. The office is located at 750 Miller Drive, SE, Suite C in Leesburg.
