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Supplemental Real Estate & Personal Property Tax Deadline is February 5

Loudoun County Treasurer H. Roger Zurn Jr. reminds taxpayers that payments for supplemental real estate and personal property taxes are due Tuesday, February 5, 2019.

Payments postmarked after February 5, 2019, will incur a 10 percent late payment penalty. Additional interest at the rate of 10 percent per annum will be assessed. The due date will not be extended for bills where assessment questions have been filed with the Board of Equalization.

Payments can be made using electronic check (eCheck), VISA, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. Please note that there is a convenience fee added to payment card transactions. There is no fee for eCheck. Payments may be made:
