Absentee Voting for November Election Begins Friday, September 20; Voter Registration Deadline is October 15

Absentee balloting for the November 5, 2019, general election will begin Friday, September 20, 2019, in Loudoun County, while the deadline to register to vote in the election is October 15, 2019.

Offices on the ballot on November 5, 2019, include members of the Virginia General Assembly, Loudoun County Board of Supervisors, Commissioner of the Revenue, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff, Treasurer, and directors of the Loudoun Soil and Water Conservation District. Voters will also be asked to decide several bond questions for parks and recreation, public safety, school and transportation projects.
