

Business Interruption Grants - Round 3 Apply Before Noon on June 6!



The Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to spend \$2 million of our new CARES Act funding on the COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund. Thanks to this new infusion of cash, the Fund can give \$5,000 grants to 400 more Loudoun businesses. If you own a business here in Loudoun and haven't gotten a grant from this program yet, I strongly encourage you to apply.

To qualify for a grant, your business must:

- Have between 0 and 2 W-2 employees (no limit on 1099 contractors),
- Have less than \$2.5 million in gross annual receipts,
- Have at least a 25% loss in revenue that can be attributed to COVID-19,

- Be a licensed and operational for-profit business in Loudoun County, VA, and
- If the applicant business received a grant from the COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund in the first or second rounds, they are not eligible to apply again.

The fund is open for applications right now, and will accept your application anytime until noon on June 6. All submissions will be accepted based on the time stamp that the application was received, verified by county employees, and placed into a pool. When the application period ends, county staff will randomly select qualified businesses from the pool until there are no more funds left to give.
