Hanson Regional Park Updates!

Light Testing Begins Tomorrow

Construction Work Continues

Light Testing to Begin Thursday, October 21

Loudoun County has scheduled daytime testing of lights at the site of the Hal and Berni Hanson Regional Park beginning Thursday, October 21, 2021, weather permitting. Area residents will notice increased activity at the park prior to the testing date. The testing will begin during the daytime hours throughout each section of the park.

In November 2021, Loudoun County is scheduled to begin night time light testing at the 17 athletic fields. During the testing, lighting at the fields will be turned on and off and dimmed. The county will begin testing at dusk and will continue for several hours.

Construction Continues

Crews continue construction work on the various features and structures throughout the park.



Current work on park features includes the installation of a concrete slab at the splashpad and play equipment at the west side playground.

Work on various structures throughout the park continues, including the installation of siding and trim, windows, roofing, insulation, fire protection, interior painting, utility rough-in and ductwork. Crews have also begun caulking, to hang drywall, and installing interior floor finishes and ceramic tile.

At Hanson House, crews are caulking and painting exterior siding.

Ongoing work throughout the park includes installation of underground utilities, electrical transformers, installation of turf irrigation systems and pouring concrete at site stairs, plazas and sidewalks. Crews will also continue paving asphalt trails, installing athletic field turf, and seeding throughout the project site.



About the Hal and Berni Hanson Regional Park

This project includes the design and construction of a new 257-acre regional park located on Evergreen Mills Road in Arcola, between the Brambleton and Willowsford communities. The park will be operated by the Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services.



When completed, the park will feature:

- 17 lighted athletic fields, including two artificial turf fields and one cricket field;
- five ponds;
- the historic Hanson House;
- an event lodge and nature center;
- a skate plaza and disc golf course;
- a splash pad and playground with inclusive features; and
- over 75 acres of passive recreational space.
