First-Half Real Property Tax Deadline is June 5, 2023

Loudoun County Treasurer H. Roger Zurn Jr. reminds taxpayers that the deadline for payment of the first-half real property tax is Monday, June 5, 2023.

Note that payments received or postmarked after June 5, 2023, will incur a 10% penalty and interest. Any penalty, when assessed, will

become part of the tax with interest accruing on both the tax and penalty at a rate of 10% annually. The due date will not be extended for bills where assessment questions have been filed with the Board of Equalization.

Metro Summer Construction Continues June 3, With Four Orange Line Station Closures in Virginia

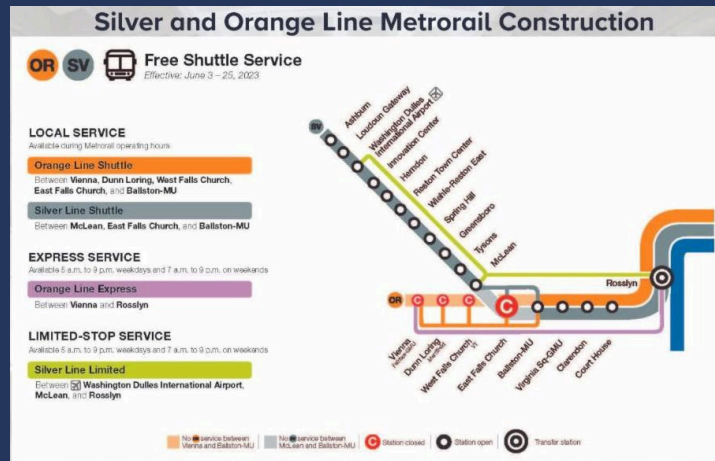
Beginning Saturday, June 3, Metro will begin rail replacement work on the Orange Line in Virginia. During construction, which will be done in two phases to minimize station closures, Metro will replace the original 40-year-old steel rail between Ballston-MU and Vienna stations.

Replacing the track in this section is a top priority to ensure safety and increase reliability. Crews will also install fiber-optic cables during this shutdown to modernize communications and allow for more efficient maintenance in the future.

Free shuttle bus service will be available for customers during all station closures. Customers are advised to plan extra time for their travel. Metro is boosting outreach to customers at the affected stations and will have prominent signage, announcements in stations and on trains, and teams of outreach personnel to assist customers with the temporary travel patterns during the construction.

Customers will continue to have normal or near normal service outside of the work zones, with frequent service on the busiest parts of the system in the downtown core area with stations served by multiple lines. Between Rosslyn and Stadium-Armory and between L'Enfant Plaza and Mt Vernon Sq trains will arrive at stations every 4-6 minutes all day.

Claude Moore Recreation & Community Center Annual Maintenance Closure

The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services announces Claude Moore Recreation and Community Center will temporarily close for annual maintenance of the facility Monday, June 5, through Sunday, June 11, 2023. The facilities gymnasium, fitness areas, climbing wall and other non-pool related features will reopen at 5:00 a.m., Monday, June 12.



The competition and leisure pools will remain closed for maintenance through Tuesday, June 13. Pool operations and water-based programs will resume Wednesday, June 14.

CASA Academy at the Claude Moore Recreation and Community Center will not be impacted by the closure.

During the annual maintenance, patrons of the facility are encouraged to visit the Dulles South Recreation and Community Center to enjoy the facility's recreational amenities, including the 25-yard by 50-meter competition pool and the leisure pool featuring a 125-foot water slide, children's play area, hot tub, vortex, lazy river, and free swim and play area. The Dulles South Recreation and Community Center is located at 24950 Riding Center Drive in South Riding. Other indoor swimming opportunities for patrons include the Round Hill Indoor Aquatic Center located at 17010 Evening Star Drive, Round Hill.
