Gentleman,

On April 05, 2017 at approximately 1730 hrs., I was involved in an incident where my vehicle rolled over me and trapped me. As a result, Loudoun County's Sheriff's Department, Loudoun County Fire & Rescue and PMI Air Medical participated in my rescue. In short, I wanted to take a moment to thank "all" the individuals involved in my rescue.

My hope is both of you would pass my appreciation to each responder and rescuer. I hope you recognize each person in front of their peers for doing a superb job. I also hope you pat yourself on the back, because it's your leadership that resulted in a well-organized rescue. If you didn't run an organized department, its likely things could have turned for the worse. Bottom line, your staff are a reflection of your character and leadership, thus the reason why I give you credit too.

I would also ask you to please consider recognizing two outstanding citizens, who acted quickly and provided the necessary lifesaving measures that kept me alive until the Sheriff Deputies and Fire & Rescue could respond. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], immediately responded to my crises when they saw I was unconscious and trapped by my vehicle.

[REDACTED] coolly assessed the situation, developed a plan, then instructed his son to retrieve paving blocks, while he ran to the garage to retrieve a 4-ton car jack. Within minutes [REDACTED] expertly raised the car, despite the car's location on uneven ground and on a steep incline. [REDACTED] successfully elevated the car at a height high enough to let me regain spontaneously breathing again, despite the complicated situation of a car trapping a human being on uneven terrain, on a steep incline, with only one car jack in place. [REDACTED] did this at risk to himself, because the precariously nature of the car jack could have given out at any time, whereby causing himself harm. [REDACTED] actions allowed responders and rescuers to safely raise the car higher, which permitted me to be freed from the vehicle. If it weren't for Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] quick response, it's likely I would be dead or brain dead from traumatic asphyxiation. Without a doubt, [REDACTED] and his son should be recognized for their critical role in my rescue.

Despite my wounds, left pneumothorax, left fractured clavicle, 8 or more fractured ribs, two cervical fractures and two fractures involving my long spine, I'm very grateful to be alive and look forward to being the best father and assistant scout master I can be for my son [REDACTED]

In closing, thank you again for your leadership in developing and maintaining strong responders and rescuers. Please let your staff know I sincerely appreciate their kindness and professionalism. God bless.

Re Motorcycle accident at [REDACTED] Ferry Road on 6 April 2017

Dear Sheriff Chapman

Sometime in the evening of 5 April a motor cyclist left the road near the intersection of Kidwell Road and Harpers Ferry Road. The motor cycle ended up in our pasture bordering the road and screened from the road by trees and brush and was not discovered until near noon today (6 April).

The accident was on a busy road and the incident was extended because of difficulty finding the body and then of removing both the body and motor cycle. The scene was managed by Captain Gary Gaither who organized the traffic control and the search for the cyclist and who, when he realized that the he was not dealing with an in and out accident, called up the appropriate traffic control vehicles. He coordinated with me, the property owner, to get access to first the motorcycle and then the body seeking and using a route best followed in consideration of the extreme wetness of the pasture — near quagmire. When cycle and body had been removed another representative of the Sheriffs department appeared to get information with respect to me and the property damage —fencing of a sheep pasture —that had occurred.

The purpose of this letter is to recognize the outstanding job done by Captain Gaither in managing a situation of some complexity and the competence of the supporting individuals.. My wife who for seven years was the only EMT/Cardiac technician in the southern third of Virginia Beach said she had never seen a better managed accident scene and threatened that if I didn't write she would..

Too often all we see is flashing lights when we haven't been paying attention to our driving.

Thanks to you, Captain Gaither, and your department for a job well done..
