On 8/4/17 my family and I, after purchasing a vehicle at Loudoun Motors, pulled into the Shell Gas Station to fill up before our 2 1/2 hr trip back to PA. Upon arriving home I realized I was missing my wallet. In tracing my steps I knew I had left it at the gas pump in VA! Not being able to find the phone no to the gas station I cancelled all my cards (haha, lots of cards weren't there Deputy Smith!). My main concern was that I had my SS card in my wallet which was now exposed to whoever found it. The following day, Saturday, I contacted our salesman at Loudoun Motors and he graciously went over to the Shell Station to see if he could locate my wallet. Upon receiving a call back from him, he stated it was found & was in the hands of the Loudoun County Sheriff's Dept.!!! MUCH RELIEF ON MY END!!!! Upon contacting the Sheriff's Dept and speaking with Deputy Smith I soon learned that he was diverted to another call that evening and had never made it to the gas station to retrieve my wallet. He assured me in his rounds that day he would stop by Shell & then give me a call. Much to my surprise only a half hour later I received a call back from him stating they did not have my wallet there & I was to contact the Owner of the station the next day and if I didn't "get anywhere" to call the Sheriff's Dept back. Devastation again set-in as to where all my personal information was! 5 mins after hanging up with him he called me back stating he had my wallet - it had been in the safe at the gas station! I cannot say enough good things about Deputy Smith & not just because he got my wallet. He was VERY professional the entire time I dealt with him and VERY sympathetic to my situation. Some may say "Well he was only doing his job". Yes, but the manner he which he did it was outstanding! People like this are few & far between and I hope the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office realizes what an asset he is to their department! 2 days later I received my wallet with ALL the belongings in it! Thank you to all the honest people involved!


Likewise, I would like to mention my appreciation for your support on authorizing the consular visit conducted by our staff members this past July 20th, 2017. Captain Charles Richardson, Assistant Division Commander, was of great support on facilitating this process.

During the interview, Mr. Zúñiga-Robles stated that his tumors have increased in quantity from six to thirteen since January 2016. This condition raises some serious concerns. To the extent of our knowledge, no specialist has yet analyzed or studied the nature of these lumps. Also, the inmate claims to suffer periodic extreme pain that impedes his ability to walk.

We understand the copious amount of medical treatments provided and the limited resources available on Loudoun Adult Detention Center for medical care. Thus, we would highly appreciate your consideration to look over Mr. Zúñiga-Robles' health treatment.

I thank you, most sincerely, in advance for any assistance you may provide on this matter and avail myself of this opportunity to offer you the assurances of my highest consideration.
