I'm pleased to forward this compliment relating to circumstances of a vehicle breakdown incident that occurred on 10 Dec 16 at the intersection of State Highway 15 and State Highway 50 at the round-about of Crosner Corner. My stepdaughter vehicle broke down while returning a baby sitting job in the Middleburg area. Her car stalled and would not stay running, she called home for help. In midst of getting to her to help, she informed us that two other deputies had stopped asked what was wrong, she informed them, they put out fares and departed the scene (unaccompanied female was left alone, in the middle of the night on a state highway). In the meantime, I arrived to see if I could figure out the issue with the vehicle, Within a minutes of my arrival Deputy Fedkiw stopped and offered assistance. After we determined the vehicle wasn't going staying running, Deputy Fedkiw offered to call a wrecker but instead we used our roadside assist service from our insurance. After we made contact and it took about 45 minutes before the wrecker arrived. During this time, Deputy Fedkiw elected to stay with us, until the wrecker arrived and the car was loaded (he flagged traffic and ensured the safety of the wrecker driver as well as myself). He was definitely concerned for our well being as this is a very busy area and insisted that it could pose a danger at night. Given all the negative press relating to the public service first responders (cops,sheriffs, etc). It was very comforting and rewarding to receive but more to share this simple but positive a experience. Deputy Fedkiw ways, actions and efforts were most appreciated by my family. Thanks for this opportunity to provide this input. Please take time to recognize Deputy Fedkiw!!! He stayed when others drove away! Please contact, if you have additional questions.
