



Groundbreaking: Seneca Ridge Drive Road Improvements

Please join the Loudoun County Government and the Sterling community next Wednesday, October 30th at 10:00 am for the groundbreaking of the Seneca Ridge Drive roadway improvements!

The Seneca Ridge Drive road improvements will provide traffic calming benefits for residents and nearby schools. Work will take place along Seneca Ridge Drive between South Cottage Road and Augusta Drive to reduce congestion and improve pedestrian safety. Roadway improvements will include widening the roadway, adding a turn lane and improving drainage. Other improvements also include curb ramp upgrades, new pavement markings, and signage in compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act requirements.
