My office, in conjunction with the Loudoun County Department of Transportation and Capital Infrastructure (DTCI), will host an informational meeting for residents *within the highlighted boundaries on the map below* regarding the process of establishing a Residential Permit Parking District (RPPD) on West Poplar Road and its connecting streets.

The Residential Permit Parking District program helps prevent traffic congestion and hazardous conditions in residential areas, provide easier parking access to residences fronting public streets, and preserve residential character and property values in Loudoun County. This is accomplished by creating on-street parking restrictions in designated areas on public roadways in accordance with the Loudoun County Codified Ordinance Chapter 490, RPPD.
