
Duties on Election Day

- 1. Greet and direct voters to the check in station
- 2. Be sure voters have their photo ID ready to check in
- 3. Be aware of senior citizens and disabled voters in line and offer assistance
- 4. Help keep the polling area free of campaign literature
- 5. Make sure there are enough marking pens available in each polling station
- 6. Open the doors for voters and direct voters to the exits
- 7. Alert the Chief Election Officer of any problems with the building or voters
