BANK BILL PAY

Refer to *your* Financial Institution Bill Pay Service if available. All payments will need to include your Loudoun County account number that is located on the reverse side of your bill in the top-right corner. **Each bill payment must be remitted individually if the bill displays a different account number.**

A convenience fee is added to credit and debit card transactions and no convenience fee is added if paid by check, cash, or echeck online. Any payment made by check or echeck, that is returned by your financial institution for non-payment, will incur a \$40.00 fee and the payment will be voided.

Paperless Billing

Office of the Commissioner of Revenue

Late Filing Penalty

Loudoun County Ordinance Chapter 860 directs the Commissioner of the Revenue to impose a late filing penalty of 10% of the tax due for failure to report the move of a vehicle into Loudoun County or one of its incorporated towns within 60 days of the vehicle attaining situs in the county. The 10% late filing penalty will continue to be assessed and added to the base tax each tax year until the property owner completes the necessary filing.

Personal Property Tax Relief Act (PPTRA)

The Personal Property Tax Relief Act of 1998 (PPTRA) provides tax relief on the first \$20,000 of value of your personal vehicle, motorcycle, and/or pickup or panel truck, with a registered gross weight of 10,000 pounds or less. A percentage is calculated annually based on a fixed amount received from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
