Home Maintenance Schedule

Monthly

- Change HVAC filters
- Clean HVAC clean out
- Clean garbage disposal
- Clean range hood or exhaust filters
- Inspect your fire extinguishers
- Inspect basement for leaks





Home Maintenance Schedule

Quarterly

- Test smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors
- Test garage door and lube springs
- Be sure to run water in unused spaces
- Check water softener

<u>Biannually</u>

- Test water heater's pressure relief valve
- Clean house and inspect
- Replace batteries in smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors



Spring and Summer: Things to Do

- Check, Clean, Inspect
 - Gutters
 - Exterior Drains
 - Roof for leaks
- Service HVAC system
- Repair and replace window screens
- Clear dead plants and shrubs away from house and electric lines





Spring and Summer: Things to Do

- Inspect and repair grout in bathroom and kitchen
- Inspect for insects and bird nests
- Clean and Repair
 - Deck
 - Patio
 - Window wells
 - Dryer vents
 - Exhaust
- Clean the garage







Fall and Winter: Things to Do

- Flush hot water heater and remove sediment
- Get heating system ready for winter
- Turn off outdoor water faucets
- Clean chimney. Hire a professional.
- Inspect driveway for cracks and patch
- Test sump pump
- Get winter gear in order. Think snow!



Fall and Winter: Things to Do



- Check for ice dams and icicles
- Make sure electrical outlets and lights are working
- Check and tighten locks, handles, and knobs
- Check and repair caulking in water areas and on all trim
- Remove showerheads and clean out sediment


