Aerosol Cans

- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (most household-sized containers are between 10 and 20 fluid ounces); fee applies.
 - Place empty cans in designated recycling area of the facility.
 - Accepted at Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Ammunition

- NOT accepted.
- Contact the Loudoun County Fire Marshal's Office to arrange for disposal.

Animal Carcass

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Veterinary offices and other commercial businesses must comply with all business waste disposal regulations.

Antifreeze

- Accepted; no fee for recycling.
- Pour into marked container located at the Loudoun County Landfill Recycling Center.

Appliance

- Includes (but not limited to): Microwave, Dishwasher, Humidifier, Radiator.
- Accepted for a fee; additional surcharge applies to refrigerant-containing units.
- All <u>refrigerant-containing appliances</u> must be declared to the Scale Operator upon entry.
- Place metal appliances in the designated recycling area of the facility.

Asbestos

- Asbestos siding (transite) NOT accepted.
 - o Contact the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality for other disposal options.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small amounts for floor tile (typically 9-inch by 9-inch) and roofing shingles. <u>Fee applies</u>.
 - Large quantities or other types of friable and non-friable asbestos are NOT accepted. Learn more about what to do about asbestos from the <u>U.S. Environmental Protection Agency</u>.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted. Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.



Ballasts, Fluorescent Light (FLB)

- Ballasts manufactured until 1979 may contain PCBs (Polychlorinated biphenyls). Ballasts that do not contain PCBs should have a label with "No PCBs." If there is no label, the ballast should be treated like a PCB containing ballast.
- No PCBs: Accepted; fee applies. ٠
 - PCB containing or unknown:
 - **Residents:** 0
 - Accepted; fee applies.
 - Accepted Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
 - **Businesses or Commercial Operations:** 0
 - NOT accepted.
 - Contact the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality for disposal options.

Batteries

- **Residents:** •
 - Accepted; <u>fees may apply</u>.
 - Lead Acid (i.e, automotive): Place in the marked area located at the Loudoun County Landfill Recycling Center (no fee).
 - Lithium Batteries: Lithium batteries are highly flammable. Recycling these batteries is recommended.
 - All other battery types are accepted. Fees apply.
 - Batteries, except lead-acid are accepted at Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
- **Businesses or Commercial Operations:**
 - NOT accepted. 0
 - Businesses must follow rules for Universal Wastes. Contact the Virginia Department of 0 Environmental Quality for more information.
- Battery Recycling information: A to Z Recycling Resources.



Boat

- Regulations must be followed and proof provided for titled or registered boats.
 - If a registered watercraft is sold, destroyed, abandoned, or stolen, the owner is required by law to report this information within 15 days in writing. Contact the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, Boat Registration & Titling Section via email (4VAC15-380-50).
- Small boats (less than 20-feet in length) accepted for a fee.
 - Must be empty of <u>oil</u>, <u>fuel</u>, and <u>lead-acid batteries</u>.
 - Must not have a septic system.
- For larger boats, please contact a boat/marine salvage company.

Books

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Hardcover and paperback books are accepted for recycling at the <u>Loudoun County Landfill Recycling</u> <u>Center</u> (no fee).

Carpet/Rug

• Accepted for a fee.

Chemicals

- Includes (but not limited to): Herbicides/Pesticides, Pool Chemicals, Cleaning Chemicals.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); fee applies.
 - Accepted at <u>Household Hazardous Waste Events</u> for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Compressed Gas Cylinder

- Includes (but not limited to): Acetylene, Oxygen Tanks.
 - For more information on Propane Tanks, visit Propane Tanks.
- All cylinders must be declared to the Scale Operator upon entry.
- Cylinders up to 20 pounds in size are <u>accepted for a fee</u>.
- All cylinders must be <u>empty</u>, and the <u>valve must be removed</u>. Full cylinders are NOT accepted.
- Place in designated recycling area of the facility.
- For large cylinders over 20 pounds, contact the supplier for return or disposal options.



Construction/Demolition Waste

- Includes: Lumber, Wire, Sheetrock, Broken Brick, Shingles, Glass, Pipes, Concrete, Paving Materials, Metal and Plastic (if materials or empty containers are from construction).
- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Materials containing asbestos are NOT accepted. For more information, see Asbestos.
- Materials that are not construction waste include: Paints, Coatings, Solvents, <u>Asbestos</u>, Liquids, Compressed Gases, or Garbage. These items will not be accepted as construction waste.
- All commercial customers bringing CDD waste will be required to provide written documentation of waste origin upon arrival to confirm that loads are coming from sources located within Loudoun County.

Drum, Steel or Plastic

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>. Must be empty.
- Drum with open top must have the lid removed for inspection; drum with closed or welded top must have a hole drilled in it for inspection.
- If metal, place in designated recycling area of the facility.

Electronics

- Includes (but not limited to): Computer, Laptop, Monitor, Printer, Television.
- <u>Accepted for a fee.</u>
 Remove batteries prior to disposal. For more information, see <u>Batteries</u>.
- Take for recycling to a local business that accepts electronic waste; fees may apply.

Exercise Equipment/Machine

- Accepted for a fee.
- If mostly metal, place in designated recycling area of the facility.

Fencing

- Accepted for a fee.
- Separate any metal and untreated wood and place in designated areas.

Fertilizer

- Not containing pesticides or herbicides, <u>accepted for a fee</u>.
- Containing pesticides or herbicides, see <u>Pesticides</u>.



Fire Extinguisher

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>. Must be empty and the valve open.
- If the extinguisher is not empty:
 - Residents: Accepted at Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
 - Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Fireworks/Explosives

- Includes fireworks and flares.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities after completing steps below; fee applies.
 - Soak Completely submerge fireworks in a bucket of water. Allow to soak overnight.
 - Wrap Double wrap soaked fireworks in plastic wrap or plastic bags so they do not dry out.
 - Dispose Place wrapped bags in regular household garbage and take to your local solid waste facility.
 - -OR-
 - Contact the Loudoun County Fire Marshal's Office to arrange for disposal.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Businesses must follow rules for Universal Wastes. Contact the <u>Virginia Department of</u> <u>Environmental Quality</u> for more information.

Flammable Liquids, excluding Gasoline

- Includes: Brake Fluid, Lighter Fluid, Paint Thinner, Mineral Oil, Mineral Spirits, Solvents, and Tiki Torch Fuel.
 - <u>Do NOT</u> pour these items into motor oil tank at <u>Loudoun County Landfill Recycling Center</u>. (Example: Brake fluid is primarily glycol-ether based and not oil.)
 - Motor Oil, Engine Oil, Heating Oil, Hydraulic Oil, Diesel Fuel, Kerosene, Lamp Oil, Power Steering Fluid, and Transmission Fluid are accepted at the <u>Loudoun County Landfill Recycling</u> <u>Center</u>.
- <u>Gasoline and Gas/Oil Mixtures</u> are NOT accepted.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); <u>fee</u> <u>applies</u>.
 - Accepted at <u>Household Hazardous Waste Events</u> for no fee.
 - Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - \circ NOT accepted.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Furniture

- Includes (but not limited to): Bookshelf, Chair, Couch, Mattress or Box Spring, Table.
- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.



Gasoline or Gasoline/Oil Mixture

- NOT accepted.
- Residents: Accepted at Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations: Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Gasoline Tank, Automotive

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>. Must be empty of fuel.
- Tank must have an opening for inspection or a hole drilled in it.

Glues and Adhesives

- Includes: Roof Adhesive, Driveway Sealant
- No Asbestos glues or adhesives accepted.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); <u>fee</u> <u>applies</u>.
 - Accepted at Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - Latex or non-hazardous accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); <u>fee applies</u>.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Grill, Outdoor Electric or Gas

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- <u>Propane Tank</u> must be removed from gas grill.
- Place grill without tank in designated recycling area of the facility.

Helium Tank

- Accepted for a fee.
- Must be empty and have valve and relief disc removed.
- Place in designated recycling area of the facility.
- For instructions, visit <u>How to Recycle Balloon Time Helium Tank</u>.

Inert Waste

- Includes: Dirt, Mud, Rock, Sand, Sediment, and Soil.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT ACCEPTED
 - o NO COMMERCIAL Dirt, Mud, Rock, Sand, Sediment, or Soil is Accepted.
 - For other commercial disposal sites, please check the internet for "Fill Dirt" or "Dirt Broker."
- Residents: <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Place in designated inert waste area at the facility.



Kegs

- Accepted for a fee.
- Must be empty and remove ABC registration sticker.
- Return to purchase location.

Land Clearing Debris

• NOT Accepted.

Lawn Mower

• <u>Accepted for a fee</u>. Must be empty of <u>oil</u>, fuel, and <u>batteries</u>.

Light Bulbs

- Incandescent bulbs and LED (light emitting diode) bulbs are <u>accepted for a fee</u>.
- Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs), Fluorescent Tubes (Lamps), Neon, Mercury Vapor, Metal Halide Lamps, or Halogen Bulbs
 - Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities; <u>fee applies</u>.
 - Unbroken bulbs/tubes are accepted at <u>Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste</u> <u>Events</u> for no fee.
 - Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Businesses must follow rules for Universal Wastes. Contact the <u>Virginia Department of</u> <u>Environmental Quality</u> for more information.

Manure (Animal)

• <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.

Medical Waste

- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY if generated AT HOME BY RESIDENT; <u>fee applies</u>. (Medical waste generated commercially or by a health care worker in your home or other location is the responsibility of that commercial entity or health care worker and must be disposed of in accordance with applicable state regulations for medical waste.)
 - Needles and syringes must be placed in a rigid container with a screw-on cap, such as an empty laundry detergent or bleach bottle, with tape wrapped around the closed cap. Label the container "CAUTION, DO NOT RECYCLE."
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Businesses, commercial entities, and home health care workers must follow rules for Regulated Medical Waste. Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for more information.



Medicine

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Keep medicine in the original container and cross out person's name and prescription number. For pills, add some salt water to start dissolving them. For liquids, add something inedible like cat litter, dirt, or ash. Seal the container and secure the lid with tape.
- PLEASE do not flush unused medicines down the toilet or pour them down the drain because they can end up in rivers and streams and harm the environment.
- Take to a Medication Disposal Drop Box. For more information, visit <u>Proper Disposal of Unused</u> <u>Medications</u>.

Mercury Thermometer/Thermostat

- Includes (but not limited to): mercury thermometers, thermostats, switches.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities; fee applies.
 - o Accepted Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Businesses must follow rules for Universal Wastes. Contact the <u>Virginia Department of</u> <u>Environmental Quality</u> for more information.

Metal, Scrap

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Place in designated recycling area at the facility.

Oil, Cooking

• Accepted ONLY in small quantities (five gallon-container or less); fee applies.

Oil, Motor

- Includes: Motor Oil, Engine Oil, Heating Oil, Hydraulic Oil, Diesel Fuel, Kerosene, Lamp Oil, Power Steering Fluid, and Transmission Fluid
- July 2023 Update: Up to 5 gallons per customer per week is accepted; no fee for recycling.
- Pour into marked used oil tank or leave containers in marked area located at the <u>Loudoun County</u> <u>Landfill Recycling Center</u>.

Oil Filters

- Accepted; no fee for recycling.
- Put into marked used oil filter container located at the Loudoun County Landfill Recycling Center.

Paint, Latex

• Accepted in-household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); fee applies.



Paint, Oil-based

- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); fee applies.
 - o Accepted at Loudoun County Household Hazardous Waste Events for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options.

Pallets

- Both wood and plastic <u>accepted for a fee</u>.
- Cannot be recycled; place in designated area of the facility.

Pesticides/Herbicides, Empty Containers

- Accepted for a fee.
- Do NOT recycle containers as residue can be a contaminant.
- Please follow "Triple Rinse" guidelines to clean containers. More information can be found on the <u>Ag</u> <u>Container Recycling Council</u> website.

Propane Tank

- Propane tanks from 1 to 20 pounds accepted for a fee; additional surcharge applies.
- Empty tanks and tanks with propane are accepted.
- All propane tanks must be declared to the Scale Operator upon entry.
- Place in designated collection area of the facility.
- For propane tanks over 20 pounds, contact the supplier for return or disposal options.

Refrigerant-Containing Appliance (Refrigerator)

- Includes (but not limited to): Air Conditioner, Dehumidifier, Freezer, Ice Maker/Ice Machine, Refrigerator.
- Accepted for a fee; surcharge applies.
- All refrigerant-containing appliances must be declared to the Scale Operator upon entry.
- Place refrigerant containing appliances in the designated area of the facility.

Rubber Tracks/Skid Loader Tracks

- Accepted for a fee.
- Not recycled; place in designated area of the facility.



Septic Tank

- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>. Tank must be empty and clean, with less than 10% residue and no free liquids.
- Place in designated area of the facility.
- Note that a permit (<u>Septic Install, Repair, or Abandonment Application</u>) needs to be obtained from the Loudoun County Health Department before removal. For more information, contact the <u>Loudoun</u> <u>County Health Department</u>.

Shipping Crate

- Wood and plastic crates are <u>accepted for a fee</u>.
- Cannot be recycled; place in designated area of the facility.

Smoke Detector

• Accepted for a fee.

Spill Clean-up Material

- Includes: petroleum-contaminated soil.
- Residents:

٠

- Accepted; <u>fee applies</u>.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - Contact the <u>Virginia Department of Environmental Quality</u> for disposal options or search online for companies that handle "contaminated soil disposal in Washington DC metro area."

Storage Tank, Steel Aboveground or Underground

- Up to 1,000 gallon capacity <u>accepted for a fee</u>.
- Tank must be empty and clean. Tank must have a hole in it for inspection.
- Place in designated area of the landfill.
 - If metal, place in designated recycling area of the facility.
- Note that a permit (Storage Tank Removal Permit) needs to be obtained from Loudoun County's Fire Marshal Office before removal. For more information, contact the <u>Fire Marshal's Office</u>.

Tires

- <u>Accepted for a fee; surcharge applies</u>.
- All tires must be declared to the Scale Operator upon entry.
- Place in designated area of the facility.

Tools/Powered Equipment

- Includes (but is not limited to): Air Compressor
- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.
- Place metal tools in the designated recycling area of the facility-
- For tools that contain batteries, see <u>Batteries</u>.



Trash/Garbage

٠

• <u>Accepted for a fee</u>.

Vehicle, Registered

- Includes any registered automobile, dirt bike, moped, motorcycle, or trailer (i.e., has tags/registration).
 - \circ NOT accepted.
 - Contact a licensed auto salvage company (Code of Virginia §§ 46.2-1600 et seq).
 - If the dirt bike, moped, or trailer is not registered, then accepted for a fee.
 - Must be empty of fuel, <u>oil</u>, and <u>batteries</u>.
 - o <u>Tire surcharge applies</u>. If tire is on rim or equipment, "tire on rim" <u>surcharge applies</u>.

Vegetative/Woody Waste, Untreated

- Includes (but is not limited to): branches, grass, leaves, mulch, stumps, trees.
- **NO plastic bags.** Paper bags are accepted.
- <u>Accepted for a fee</u>. Must be under 3 feet in diameter and 8 feet in length.
- Place in designated recycling area of the facility.
- Land clearing debris is NOT accepted.
- Sod without dirt, soil, or rock is accepted with leaves/grass.

Windshield Washer Fluid

- Do NOT pour into antifreeze tank at the <u>Loudoun County Landfill Recycling Center</u>. Windshield washer fluid is primarily methyl-alcohol based and is not solely glycol-based like antifreeze.
- Residents:
 - Accepted ONLY in small quantities and household-type containers (5-gallon or smaller); fee applies.
 - Accepted at <u>Household Hazardous Waste Events</u> for no fee.
- Businesses or Commercial Operations:
 - NOT accepted.
 - o Contact the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality for disposal options.

Wood, Treated

- Includes (but is not limited to): wood products used for decks and fences, railroad ties.
- Accepted for a fee.
- Cannot be recycled; place in designated area of the facility.
