QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q1. With regard to item (g) on page 5: the Deferred Compensation, Roth IRA, and Retiree Health Savings
 - a) Is there a committee that oversees these plans?
 - b) Will quarterly performance monitoring be provided by the consultant?
 - c) Is quarterly performance monitoring currently provided? If yes, will you provide a copy of the most recent report?
 - d) Can you provide a list of the investment options available in the plans?
 - e) What type of services are currently provided regarding the Roth IRA?
 - A1. The Deferred Compensation Committee has purview over the Deferred Compensation, Roth IRA and Retiree Health Savings Plans. Plan performance monitoring will be provided by the plan administrator, not the consultant. The most recent quarterly report is attached (Attachment I) which provides investment results. See attachments for a list of investment options by plan (Attachment II). A description of the Roth IRA is attached (Attachment III).
- Q2. With regard to Retiree Health: the RFP does not specifically mention Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) 74 and 75. Can you confirm if the county intended to include GASB services in the scope?
 - A2. GASB 74 and 75 are not included in this scope.
- Q3. Does the County offer post 65 retiree coverage?
 - A3. Yes, the County does offer post 65 retiree coverage.
- Q4. Is the county able to disclose what it pays Aon to perform the current services?
 - A4. Please contact the Procurement Division at Diane.Smith@loudoun.gov for the information regarding the current pricing.
- Q5. How long has Aon been providing these services and why is the County seeking a new firm and will Aon be able to provide a proposal response?
 - A5. Aon has been the provider of actuarial services for the past ten (10) years. In accordance with the Code of Virginia, the County is required to issue solicitations and seek competition for all County services and Aon is not excluded from competition.

- Q6. If potential offerors are required to submit to interviews to determine the final selected firm, will those interviews be conducted at the County's offices, or by telephone or some other electronic means?
 - A6. The County plans to conduct the interviews at the County location to be determined. However, firms are able to make the business decision on whether or not the firm will participate via electronic means or in person.
- Q7. Are the various meetings described in the RFP held onsite at the County offices, or can they be conducted electronically (Skype, GotoMeeting or other similar service)? If the former, how many meetings are contemplated during a given calendar year?
 - A7. Meetings under this contract will occur for a variety of reasons. First, quarterly meetings will occur four (4) times a year with at least two (2) to occur onsite. There will be other meetings that may require consultative attendance such as Board of Supervisors' Meetings or new vendor employee benefit meetings. The number and frequency of these meetings are unknown at this time. Depending upon the content of the meetings, they may be conducted electronically.
- Q8. Will the County provide the interest rate(s) to be used in deriving the reserves?
 - A8. The County will rely on the Consultant for such rate(s) to be used in deriving the reserves.
- Q9. In the Minimum Qualification Requirements, Section 4.1 of the RFP requires offerors to provide proof of financial status. If a corporation is a sole owner and the company practice is not to release financial information in documents that may be made public, would the firm's Dun and Bradstreet rating be sufficient to comply with the requirements of Section 4.1? Or could the firm state in the proposal that if selected, the firm will provide the County with the necessary financial documentation before signing the contract to perform the work?
 - A9. As stated in Section 4.1 of the RFP, "The offeror shall provide proof of a positive balance sheet and profitable business operations for two (2) of the last three (3) years." There is not an alternative proposal option to the stated Offeror's Minimum Qualification requirement.
- Q10. Will the loss and exposure data be available in electronic (Excel) format?
 - A10. Yes, the loss and exposure data will be available in electronic (Excel) format to the successful offeror

- Q11. Can the County provide a copy of a typical report/analysis provided by the Aon? The copy of the report/analysis should include: reserve opinions (or quarterly reviews), Medicare Part D attestations, retirement valuations, fully insured equivalency rate development by product, renewal recommendation letters, budget analysis report, etc.
 - A11. This information for the report/analysis will be provided to the successful offeror during the Kick-Off Meeting with the County Team.
- Q12. Should all potential offerors submit a Cost Proposal or should the Cost Proposal only be submitted once a firm has passed the initial screening process?
 - A12. As stated in Section 8.7 of the RFP, only shortlisted firms will be required to submit a Cost Proposal and those firms will be notified in writing to submit the cost information prior to the interview.
- Q13. Can the County provide a sample of the Worker's Compensation Report?
 - A13. This information for the sample report will be provided to the successful offeror during the Kick-Off Meeting with the County Team.
- Q14. Does the County require that the work required for the Worker's Compensation Report be completed by a certified actuary?
 - A14. Yes, the County does require that the Worker's Compensation Report be completed by a certified actuary.
- Q15. Is CIGNA Medicare supplement plan the only medical plan offering to Medicare eligible retirees?
 - A15. Yes, the CIGNA Medicare supplement plan is the only medical plan offering to Medicare eligible retirees
- Q16. Does the County utilize the retiree benefit plan parlance as an "egg whip" (EGWP), which is a group Medicare Part D prescription drug plan option that is offered to retirees who have been promised prescription drug coverage as part of their Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) for the retiree pharmacy plan?
 - A16. Yes, the County does rely on the EGWP.
- Q17. How are retiree benefits outsourced?
 - A17. The retiree Health Third Party Administrator (TPA) is outsourced to Cigna and the Direct Bill Services for premium remittance is outsourced to Flexible Benefit Administrators.

- Q18. Who is the Health Reimbursement Account (HRA) and Health Savings Account (HSA) administrator?
 - A18. The HRA and HSA administrator is Cigna
- Q19. Section 5.1 A Benefits Consulting Services of the RFP refers to behavioral health management, tuition assistance and commuter benefits. Does the County require the successful offeror to provide only advisory services and possible RFP work on these plans?
 - A19. The expectations for services in the areas identified above are for advisory services and possible RFP facilitation.
- Q20. What is the current medical enrollment?
 - A20. The current medical enrollment is provided as Attachment IV.
- Q21. Are there any voluntary benefits (other than voluntary group life) being offered by the County?
 - A21. The voluntary benefit (other than voluntary group life) being offered by the County is the Long-Term Care, buy-up disability
- Q22. Currently, what benefits administration system is the County utilizing?
 - A22. Oracle is the benefits administration system currently utilized by the County.
- Q23. Who is the County's current payroll vendor?
 - A23. Oracle is the County's current payroll system.
- Q24. Can the County clarify the valuation dates for the July 1 workers compensation deliverables in the Project/Deliverable in Section 5.1.C?

 EX: Does the County wish to receive a roll-forward estimate of June 30 incurred but not reported (IBNR) and outstanding losses based on an earlier valuation of loss data (e.g., estimate 6/30/20 outstanding liabilities based on a roll-forward of claims data valued as of 4/30/20)? Or, does the County wish to receive outstanding loss estimates as of a date prior to June 30, without a roll-forward (e.g. estimate 5/31/20 outstanding losses based on 5/31/20 claims data)?
 - A24. The dates identified in the referenced table are target dates for the County. The actual dates for the deliverables will be part of the negotiation with the successful offeror.

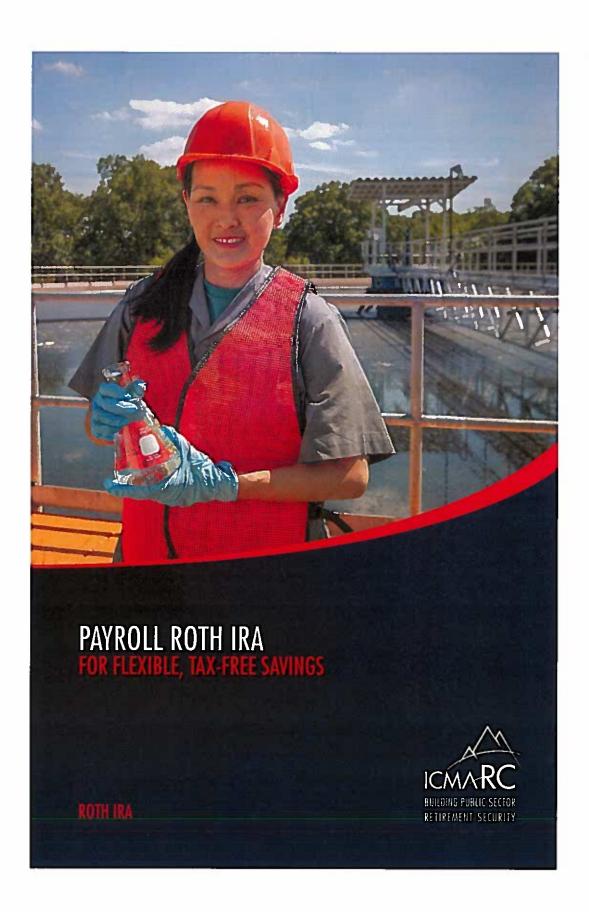

Why a Roth IRA?

BOOST YOUR SAVINGS

What are your savings goals? A Roth IRA can help you:

- Earn additional retirement income
- Set aside money in retirement for travel, gifts, or medical care
- Make a down payment on a home
- Pay for a child's college education
- Build an emergency fund

DIVERSIFY YOUR TAXES WITH TAX-FREE EARNINGS

A Roth IRA can help you manage your tax bill because withdrawals, including all earnings, may be *tax-free*. This can help offset withdrawals of other taxable employer plan and IRA assets. And it may help minimize taxation of Social Security benefits or surcharges on Medicare premiums.

A Roth IRA is a savings vehicle that can complement your employer retirement plans by allowing for tax-free earnings and, if needed, flexible withdrawals. ICMA-RC's Payroll Roth IRA allows you to make convenient contributions directly from your paycheck.

CONTROL AND FLEXIBILITY

While the longer your Roth IRA is invested, the larger the potential tax-free growth, you always retain full access to your assets. And contributions can always be withdrawn without taxes or penalties.

MATCH A ROTH IRA WITH YOUR 457 PLAN

Saving to a Roth IRA and your 457 plan may make sense because they complement each other.

There are no maintenance fees*, you can contribute as little as \$10 per pay period, and you can view your account alongside your other ICMA-RC accounts on your quarterly statement and our website (www.icmarc.org/login).

SMALL SAVING + TAX-FREE COMPOUNDING

Contributing \$25 biweekly to start, and increasing that by just \$5 per year can really add up due to compounding earnings. And those earnings can be tax-free.

Understanding Roth IRA Contributions

You have to be eligible to contribute to a Roth IRA based on your modified adjusted gross income, which is generally all of your income subject to taxes minus certain deductions, and tax filing status.

Contribution Eligibility	Single Filers Income	Married Joint Filers Income
Full Amount	Less than \$122,000	Less than \$193,000
Partial Amounts	\$122,000 - \$136,999	\$193,000 - \$202,999
None	\$137,000 or more	\$203,000 or more

There are also IRS limits on how much you can contribute to a Roth IRA.

Year	Under Age 50	Age 50 or Over (as of year end)
2019	\$6,000	\$7,000

If you own a traditional IRA: combined contributions to a Roth and Traditional IRA cannot exceed the limits.

You can make 2018 tax-year contributions until the April 2019 tax-filing deadline.*

Saver's Credit — You may be eligible for a tax credit of as much as \$1,000 if you qualify based on your income. Visit www.icmarc.org/saverscredit to learn more.

Spousal IRA — Your spouse may also make IRA contributions, based on your income, regardless of whether he/she earns income. To open an IRA for your spouse, contact your ICMA-RC representative or visit www.icmarc.org/ira.

Understanding Roth IRA Conversions

You may transfer — or convert — assets from a Traditional IRA or, if eligible, employer plan, to a Roth IRA. The assets converted are subject to tax but future earnings may be tax-free. Visit www.icmarc.org/rothconversion to learn more. In addition to taxes, you should also consider the services, investments, and costs associated with both accounts.

^{*} Current year paycheck contributions can only be made through the final pay period of the year, but prior year contributions (or additional current year contributions) may be made by sending separate payments.

Understanding Roth IRA Withdrawals

Roth IRA withdrawals can be made at any time and your contributions can always be withdrawn without taxes. Withdrawals, including earnings, are 100% tax-free if you have held a Roth IRA account for at least five years, as defined by the IRS, and either:

- You are at least age 591/2
- ► You have a qualifying "first-time" home purchase (limited to \$10,000 in Traditional IRA assets and/or Roth IRA earnings over your lifetime)
- You have a qualifying disability
- Your beneficiaries or heirs receive the assets after your death

Otherwise:

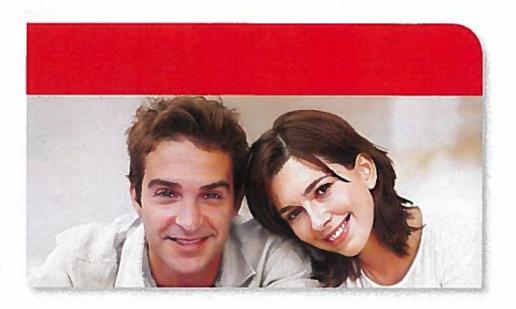
- ► The first assets withdrawn are your contributions, which are never subject to taxes or penalties.
- The next assets withdrawn are converted assets, which may be subject to a 10% penalty tax if withdrawn within five years of the conversion and you are under the age of 59½, unless you qualify for an exception.
- ▶ The last assets withdrawn are earnings, which may be subject to ordinary income taxes and, if you are under the age of 59½, the 10% penalty tax, unless you qualify for an exception.

PENALTY-FREE WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals that are subject to ordinary income taxes can avoid the IRS 10% penalty tax if you qualify for an exception, including payment of qualifying:

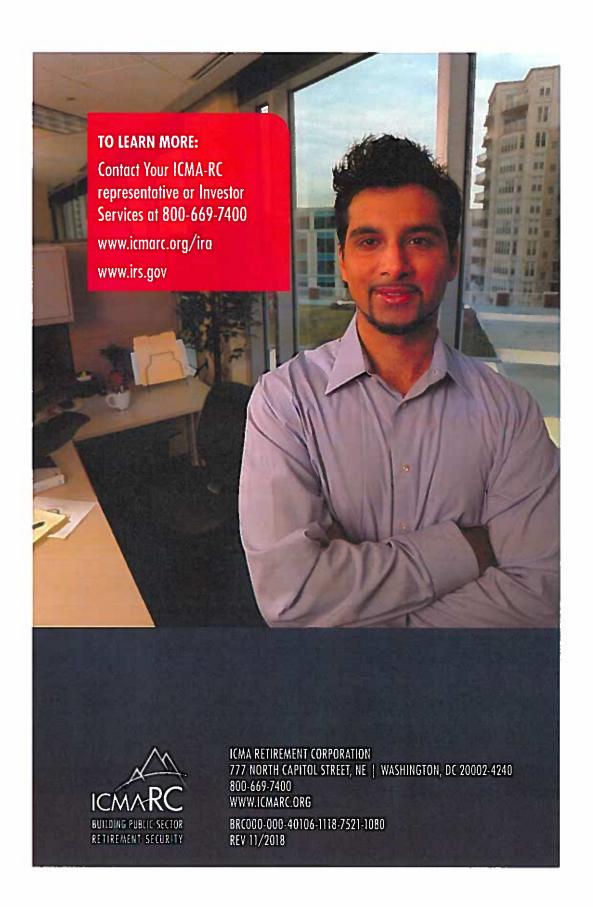
- Higher education expenses, including tuition, fees and books, for you, your spouse, children and grandchildren
- Major medical expenses
- Health insurance premiums while unemployed

Additional exceptions may apply. See IRS Publication 590 for a complete list (WWW.Irs.gov).



REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS DO NOT APPLY

Unlike Traditional IRAs and employer retirement plans, Roth IRAs are not subject to IRS required minimum distributions (RMDs), allowing you to increase potential tax-free growth in your later retirement years and/or for your loved ones after you die.
